That said Old Cahaba Residential Association claims a lien upon the following property, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

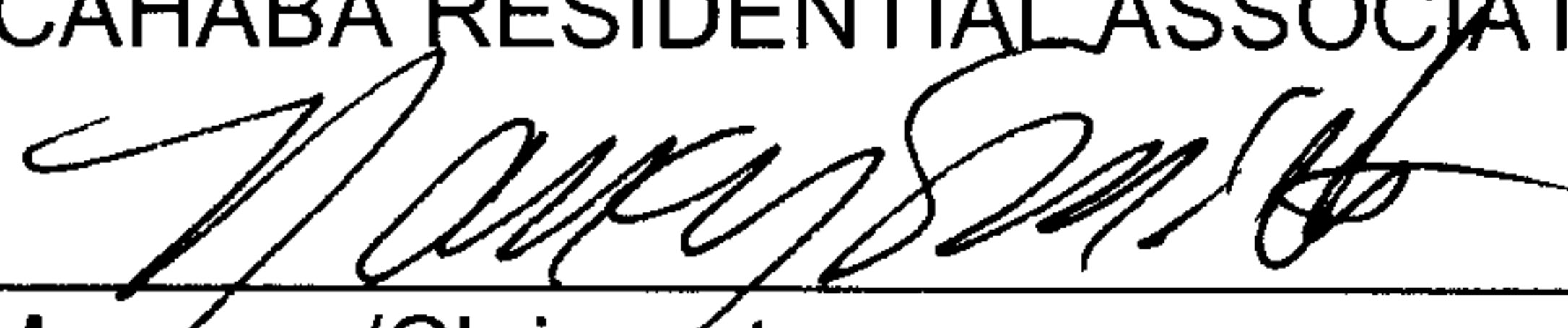

The name of the owner of the said property is Melinda Holley & Paul Goode.

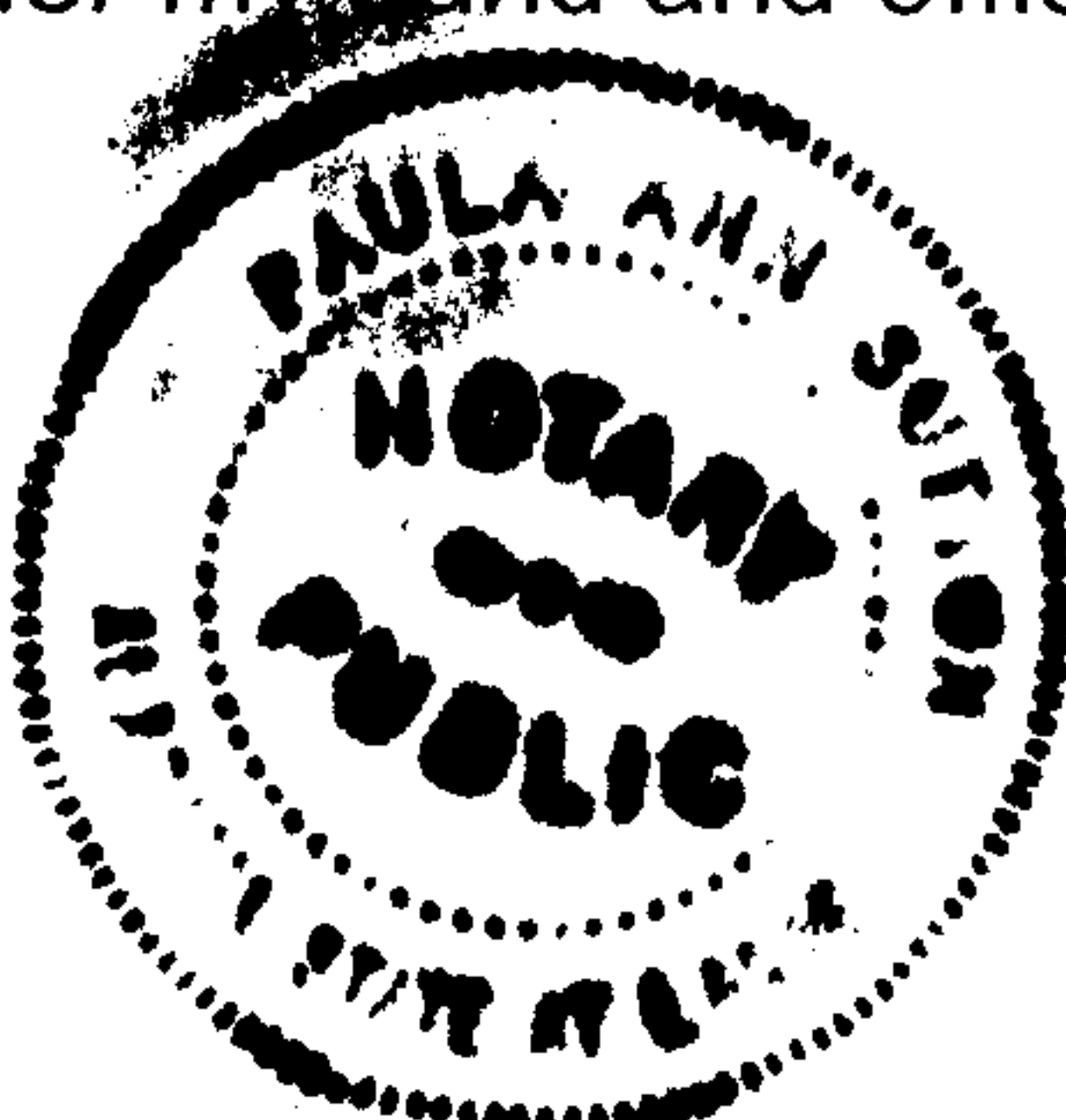
