ARTICLE V

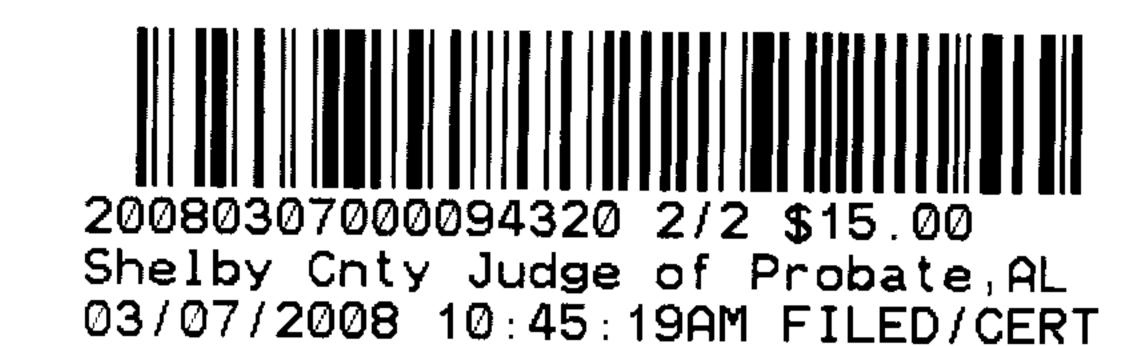
The number of shares voted for the amendment was 1,000 and the number of shares voted against such amendment was 0.
