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**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF

1. The name of the limited liability company is Clayton Land Investments, LLC, hereinafter referred to in these Articles of Organization as the "Company."

2. The period of its duration is perpetual.

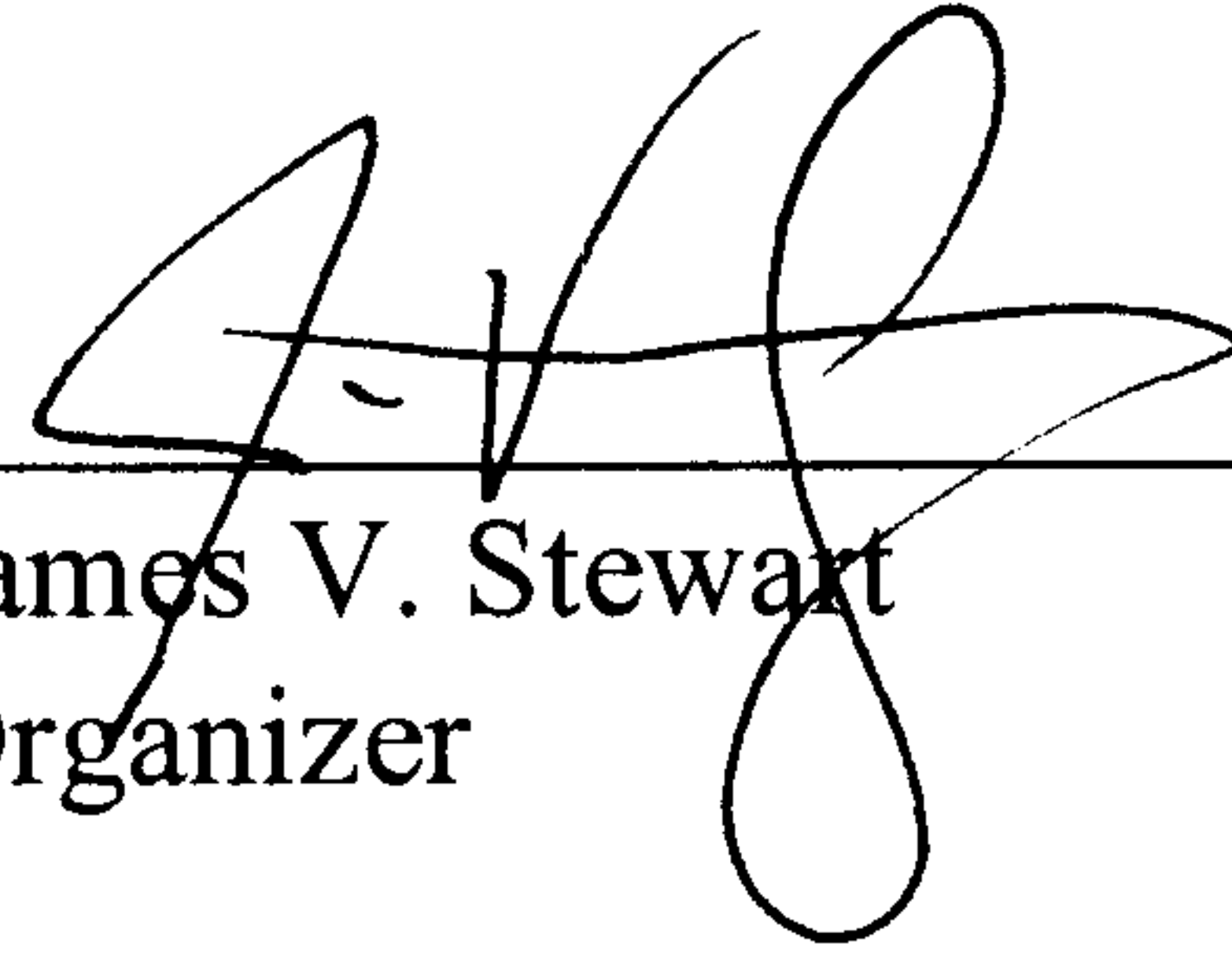
