STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED JOINT TENANTS WITH RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that in consideration of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$170,500.00) to the undersigned Thornton New Home Sales, Inc., an Alabama corporation ("Grantor"), in hand paid by, Patricia M. Nicholson and Patricia Lynn Nicholson ("Grantee"), the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the said Grantor does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Grantee, as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:



Together with the nonexclusive easement to use the Common Areas as more particularly described in The Narrows Residential Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions recorded as Inst. #2000-9755 and Instrument #2000-17136, Instrument #2000-36696, Instrument #2001-38328, Instrument #20020905000424180, Instrument #20021017000508250; and Instrument #20030716000450980 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama (which, together with all amendments thereto, is hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Declaration").

TITLE IS VESTED IN THORNTON NEW HOME SALES, INC. AS SURVIVOR IN ITS MERGER WITH THE NARROWS II, INC.

Subject to: (1) Ad valorem taxes due and payable October 1, 2008 and all subsequent years thereafter; (2) Fire district assessments for 2006 and subsequent years not yet due and payable; (3) Mineral and mining rights not owned by Grantor; (4) The easements, restrictions, covenants, agreements and all other terms and provisions of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions recorded in Instrument #2000-9755, Instrument #2000-17136, Instrument #2000-36696, Instrument #2001-38328, Instrument #20020905000424180, Instrument #20021017000508250; and Instrument #20030716000450980 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; (5) All easements, restrictions, reservations, agreements, rights-of-way, building setback lines and any other matters of record.

Grantee, by acceptance of this deed, acknowledges, covenants and agrees for itself and for its successors and assigns, that Grantor shall not be liable for and Grantee hereby waives and releases and forever discharges Grantor, its officers, agents, employees, directors, shareholders, partners, contractors, subcontractors, mortgagees and



each of their respective successors and assigns, for any and all liability, claims and causes of action of any nature on account of loss, damage, or injuries to buildings, structures, improvements, personal property or to Grantee or any owner, occupants or other person who enters upon any portion of the Property as a result of or arising out of any past, present or future soil, surface and/or subsurface conditions known or unknown (including, without limitation, radon, sinkholes, underground mines, tunnels and limestone formations and deposits) under or upon the Property or any property surrounding, adjacent to or in close proximity with the Property.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, to the said Grantee, as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein) in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.
