ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF EMH QUANTUM LEAP, LLC

The undersigned, acting as the organizer of a limited liability company under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, Code of Alabama, Title 10, Chapter 12 (1975), as the same may be amended from time to time, hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization for EMH QUANTUM LEAP, LLC (the "limited liability company"):

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the limited liability company is EMH QUANTUM LEAP, LLC.

ARTICLE TWO PERIOD OF DURATION

The limited liability company shall continue in existence until dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the limited liability company's operating agreement, or, if there is no provision in an operating agreement of the limited liability company governing dissolution of the limited liability company, then in accordance with the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act.

ARTICLE THREE PURPOSE

The business of the company shall be, to the extent permitted by law, (1) to engage in the business of internet sales, marketing and distribution of various products and activities related thereto; (2) to have and exercise all powers set forth in Code of Alabama, Section 10-12-4 (1975), as the same may be amended from time to time; and (3) to engage in any lawful business or other activity, whether or not related or incidental to any of the foregoing activities.

ARTICLE SIX ADDITIONAL MEMBERS


Additional members may be admitted in accordance with the terms of the limited liability company's operating agreement. If the limited liability company does not have an operating agreement that provides for the admission of additional members, additional members may be admitted with the written consent of all members at such times and upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the members and the person desiring to become a member.

ARTICLE SEVEN CONTINUATION OF THE BUSINESS

In the event there are no remaining members, and except as otherwise provided in the limited liability company operating agreement, the limited liability company shall be dissolved and its affairs shall be wound up unless:

(a) the holders of all the financial rights in the limited liability company agree in writing within ninety (90) days after the cessation of membership of the last member, to continue the legal existence and business of the limited liability company and to appoint one or more new members; or

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(b) The legal existence and business of the limited liability company is continued and one or more new members are appointed in the manner stated in an operating agreement of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE EIGHT MANAGEMENT

The management of the Company is vested in its managers. The names and address of the initial manager of the Company is Mike Holder. The initial manager shall serve until his successors are elected and shall qualify. Subject to any provisions in an operating agreement of the Company, or the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act restricting or enlarging the management rights and duties of any person or group or class of persons, the manager shall have the right and authority to manage the business or affairs of the Limited Liability Company and to make all decisions with respect thereto.

ARTICLE NINE AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

These Articles of Organization may be amended only by the unanimous vote or written consent of the members of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE TEN INCORPORATION OF PROVISIONS OF OPERATING AGREEMENT

The provisions of the limited liability company's operating agreement, if any, are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein.
