

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

WALKER LAW FIRM, LLC, (AN ALABAMA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY)

Pursuant to the provisions of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975), Section 10-12-1, et seq., the undersigned hereby adopts the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the limited liability company is Walker Law Firm (hereinafter referred to as "Company").

ARTICLE II


DURATION

The Company shall have a duration from the date of organization until forty (40) years thereafter, unless it is dissolved and its affairs wound up prior to that date in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Act").

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Company is formed are to provide legal services pursuant to the practice of law and to provide all professional services which its member(s) may be licensed to provide, and to engage in any other lawful act or activity for which limited liabilities companies may be organized pursuant to the Act.

ARTICLE VI


ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS
