ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on a Complaint filed by the Plaintiff to enjoin the Defendant from continued violations of the coverage provisions of The Alabama Workers' Compensation Law. A hearing was held on June 17, 2008. The Defendant failed to appear at the hearing and has failed to file any answer or present any evidence in opposition to the allegations contained in the complaint. The court having considered same, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. The Defendant is in violation of the coverage provisions of The Alabama Workers' Compensation Law. The Defendant shall provide proof of workers' compensation insurance coverage to the Alabama Department of Industrial Relations within ten (10) days of the date of this Order. The Defendant is further enjoined from continued operation of the business until proof of workers' compensation insurance coverage is provided to the Plaintiff.

2. In finding the Defendant to be in violation of the coverage provisions of The Alabama Workers' Compensation Law, this Court finds the Defendant guilty of a


misdemeanor and imposes an immediate fine of \$1,000.00. Said fine shall be due and payable immediately to the Alabama Department of Industrial Relations – Workers' Compensation Division

3. In addition to the \$1,000.00 fine as stated above, the Court imposes a civil penalty against the Defendant in the amount of \$100.00 per day for each day the Defendant fails to provide proof of insurance coverage after the expiration of the ten (10) day period as stated above.

4. The Defendant is responsible for the payment of all court costs in this action.
