**PROTECTION ORDER**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Plaintiff's Petition For Protection From Abuse and the Court's Ex Parte Protection Order, Protection From Abuse Act, Sec.30-5-1, et seq., *Alabama Code* 1975, entered June 27, 2007 and continued for trial to August 8, 2007. Present in open Court were the plaintiff, represented by the Hon. Mary Lee Abele, and the defendant, represented by the Hon. M. Scott Harwell. Upon consideration thereof, with argument of counsel and *ore tenus* testimony, the Court is of the opinion that the following order is due to be entered. Accordingly, it is hereby

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** by the Court as follows:

1. The Court finds that there is good cause for the Protection Order entered June 27, 2007 inasmuch as the plaintiff has set out and the Court is satisfied that the defendant has engaged in the act of harassing communication.

2. All prior Orders of this Court shall remain in full force and effect, subject to consolidation with and modification in pending proceedings in the Domestic Relations Division and subject to the following:

a. Defendant may contact the minor children by telephone and may resume visitation ordered in the Final Judgment of Divorce entered August 5, 2005 so long as the parties have no contact with each other and agree to a third party to meet the defendant with the children for pick-up and delivery at a designated meeting place.

b. All Orders regarding the marital home located at 34 Hillside Lane, Westover, Alabama shall remain in effect but are hereby consolidated with and subject to modification in pending proceedings in the Domestic Relations Division.



c. All issues of contempt are hereby continued to be consolidated with pending proceedings in the Domestic Relations Division.

d. Any further matters shall be handled in concert with this proceeding or pending proceedings in the Domestic Relations Division.

3. The defendant shall pay to the plaintiff the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) in attorney's fees pursuant to the Protection From Abuse Act.
