The name of the owner of the said property is Jesse and Angelica Clark.

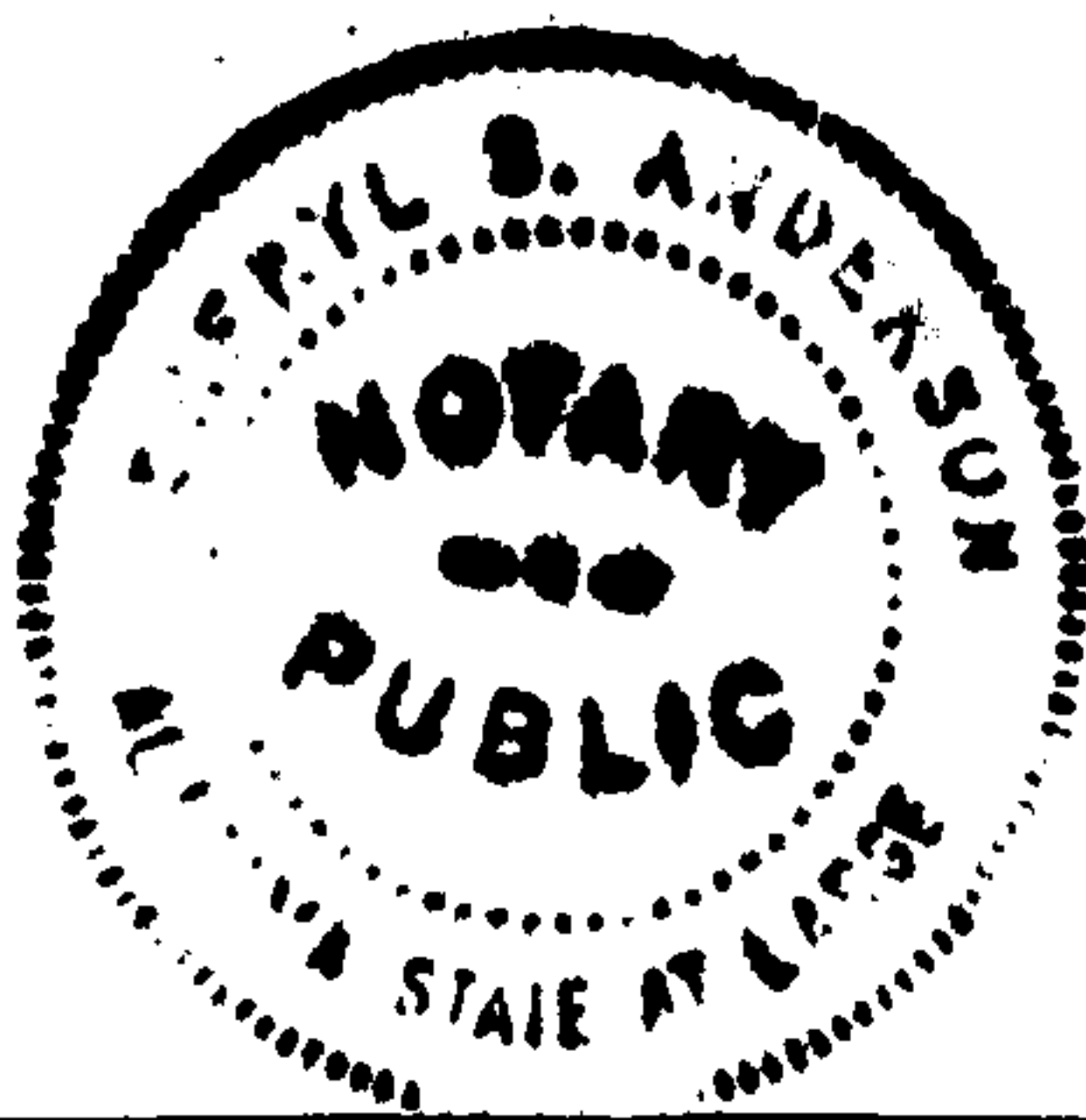
