Before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said county and said state, personally appeared James W. Fuhrmeister, who after being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

“My name is James W. Fuhrmeister and I am the Probate Judge for Shelby County, Alabama. On June 23, 2006, as a practicing attorney in the State of Alabama, I prepared a Corrective Statutory Warrant Deed, conveying certain real property located in Jefferson County, Alabama and executed by James M. White, a married man (Grantor) to Ramiro Castro and Irma Castro, husband and wife (Grantees). This deed was recorded on July 18, 2006 at Instrument Number 20060718000864360 in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama.

Due to an oversight, Exhibit A contained the incorrect Legal Description. The last sentence of the description reads:

‘...; thence turn 9 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds left, South for 144.62 feet to the point of beginning.’

The last sentence of the correct Legal Description should read:


‘...; thence turn 90 degrees 32 minutes 29 seconds left, South for 144.62 feet to the point of beginning.’
