


STEP 1: THIS FORM IS A GUIDELINE FOR COMPLETING YOUR ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION. TO INCORPORATE, FILE THE ORIGINAL AND TWO COPIES OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE CORPORATION'S REGISTERED OFFICE IS LOCATED. THE SECRETARY OF STATES FILING HEETS \$20. PLEASE CONTACT JUDGE OF PROBATE TO VERIFY FILING HEES. STEP 2: NON-PROFIT CORPORATIONS MUST HAVE AT LEAST THREE DIRECTORS.

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ALABAMA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

Articles of Incorporation



In response to the need to strengthen families through the implementation of counseling, education and prevention programs; be it resolved that the members of the organization herein referred to as Ray of Hope, do hereby offer the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I. The name of the organization shall be called Ray of Hope Counseling Center.

ARTICLE II. The duration of the organization shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. The purpose of the organization shall be to: 1) Provide faith-based counseling, assessment, intervention and referral services to individuals and families in our service-delivery area, 2) Provide prevention/education services to community groups, schools and churches in its service-delivery area, including tutorial/mentoring programs to at risk youth, 3) Publish, print and disseminate information and literature pertaining to our services and to promote the spiritual & emotional well-being of those in our service-delivery area.

ARTICLE IV. The officers of the organization's board shall include, but not be limited to the following: President, Vice President, Secretary and Executive Director/CEO. The organization shall be accountable to a Board of Directors, comprised of no less than five (5) and no more than ten (10) persons. The Board, along with the Executive Director, shall have the authority to make decisions on behalf of the organization. However, the primary responsibility for daily operation and program development shall rest with the Executive Director/CEO. Board members shall serve for one year, subject to reappointment or election by simple majority.

ARTICLE V. The street address of the organization is 765 West Street, Montevallo, Alabama, 35115.
