**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
J & C CHURCH PROPERTIES, LLC**

1. The name of the limited liability company is J & C CHURCH PROPERTIES, LLC.
2. The limited liability company will have perpetual existence.
3. The purpose of the LLC is organization of a company for residential and commercial real estate investment.


