


Amendment to Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE III (Purpose)


Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501-C (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

- The specific purposes of the corporation are for the building of the Greater Emmanual Community Church, Inc., and to carry on religious, educational and charitable work under the rules and regulations of this body, in harmony with these Articles of Incorporation and laws of the State of Alabama.
- To issue license to preach the gospel according to the teaching of the Bible and ritual of this corporation <u>to</u> ordain elders and deacons and to choose, assign and ordain Bishops in any state in the Union or any other country.
- To have all powers not inconsistent with provisions contained in Title 10, Sections 124-132, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1940, recompiled 1975 and all other laws of the State of Alabama dealing with and pertaining Religious, Churches, Educational and Benevolent Corporations.

Powers: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of the articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501-c 3 of the Internal Revenue Code or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 c 2 of the Internal Revenue Code.



B. <u>Dissolution</u>: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a Court of Common Pleas in the Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are operated exclusively for such purposes.
