ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF ALLPRO TREE & STUMP SERVICE, LLC

The undersigned, desiring to establish a Limited Liability Company pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama, certifies as follows:

- 1. NAME OF LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY: The name of the Limited Liability Company is "AllPro Tree & Stump Service, LLC".
- 2. **PERIOD OF DURATION:** The existence of the Limited Liability Company shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and its duration shall be perpetual, provided, however, that the Limited Liability Company shall be dissolved (a) upon the written consent of all Members; (b) as provided in the Operating Agreement of the Limited Liability Company; or (c) as may be required or provided for by the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act").
- 3. **PURPOSES:** The purposes for which this Limited Liability Company is organized are:
 - (a) To engage in business of tree and stump removal, tree trimming and topping, storm damage cleanup, and all other general landscaping services to businesses and the general public.
 - (b) To render to others, and to engage in the business of rendering to others, consulting, advisory, administrative and other services of every nature, kind and character, which it may legally render;
 - (c) To act as agent, representative, or receiver of any person, firm, corporation, or governmental entity or instrumentality in respect to any lawful undertaking or transaction;
 - (d) To purchase, take, receive, lease or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use and otherwise deal in or with, real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated, and to sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of real or personal property, or any interest therein;
 - (e) To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, corporations, associations, partnerships, limited liability companies, individuals,

or direct or indirect obligations of governmental entitles or of any instrumentality thereof;

- (f) To lend money, invest and reinvest its funds and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested; and
- (g) To engage in any other lawful act or activity for which limited liability companies may be organized pursuant to the Act.
- 4. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT: The location of the initial registered office of the Limited Liability Company shall be 9029 Eagle Valley Lane Birmingham, AL 35242, and the name of the initial registered agent at said address is Frederick A Mackowiak.



shall set forth all provisions for the affairs of the Limited Liability Company and the conduct of its business to the extent that such provisions are not inconsistent with the Act or these Articles of Organization.
