COUNTY OF SHELBY) **JOINT SURVIVORSHIP DEED**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of **Five Hundred Thirty Thousand and 00/100 (\$530,000.00)**, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned **Malea L. Martin, an unmarried woman**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTOR does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **Rocco A. Plaia and Leetha C. Plaia**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of **Shelby**, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 11, according to the Map of Greystone 6th Sector, as recorded in Map Book 17, Page 54 A, B & C, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Together with the nonexclusive easement to use the private roadways, Common Areas and Hugh Daniel Drive, all as more particularly described in the Greystone Residential Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions dated November 6, 1990 and recorded in Real 317, Page 260, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama (which, together with all amendments thereto, is hereafter collectively referred to as the "Declaration").

Subject To:
Ad valorem taxes for 2009 and subsequent years not yet due and payable until October 1, 2009. Existing covenants and restrictions, easements, building lines and limitations of record.

Malea L. Martin is one and same person as Malea L. Manning as reflected in that certain Quit Claim Deed recorded as Instrument No. 20090708000262430 in said Probate Office.

\$400,000.00 of the consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the tract or parcel of land above described together with all and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, appurtenances, and improvements unto the said GRANTEES, for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor, forever.

AND SAID GRANTOR, for said GRANTOR, GRANTOR'S heirs, successors, executors and administrators, covenants with GRANTEES, and with GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, that GRANTOR is lawfully seized in fee simple of the said Real Estate; that said Real Estate is free and clear from all Liens and Encumbrances, except as hereinabove set forth, and except for taxes due for the current and subsequent years, and except for any Restrictions pertaining to the Real Estate of record in the Probate Office of said County; and that GRANTOR will, and GRANTOR'S heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to said GRANTEES, and GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all persons.

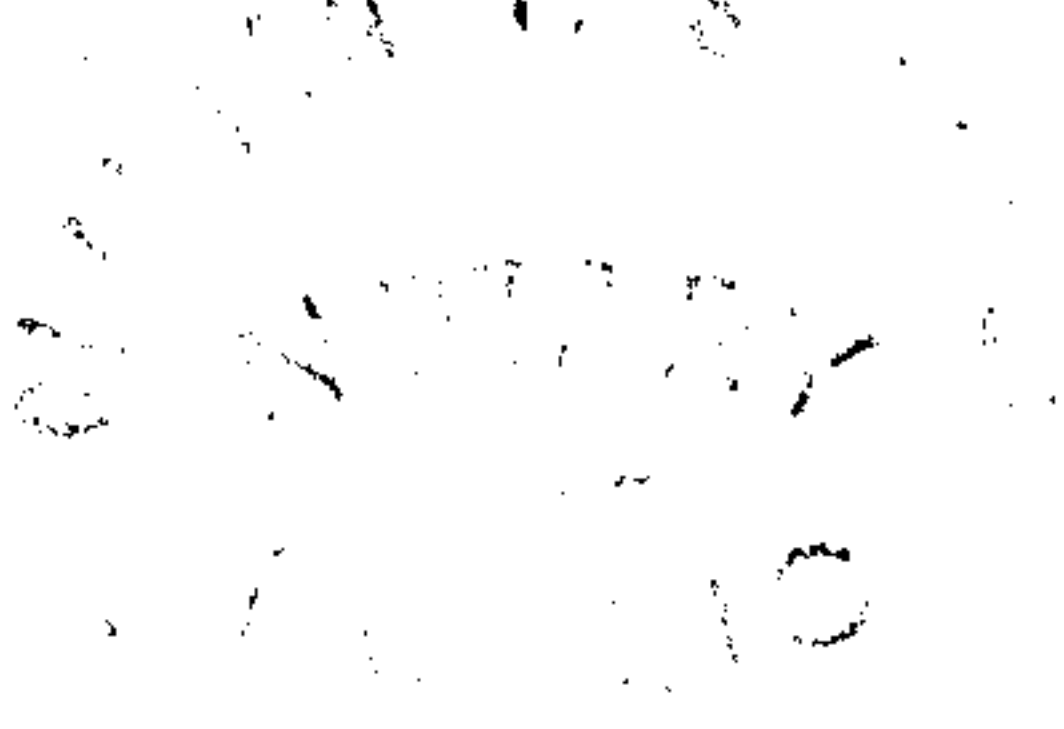
