
ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION



OF

Helping Hands Transportation Service, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under Title 10, Chapter 12 of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975), as amended (the "Alabama Limited Liability Company Act"), hereby files the following Articles of Organization with the probate judge of the County in which the initial registered office of the limited liability company will be located and attests that the facts stated in these Articles of Organization are true and correct:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this limited liability company (the "Limited Liability Company") shall be:

Helping Hands Transportation Services, LLC

ARTICLE II

DURATION


The period of duration is perpetual unless the Limited Liability Company shall be sooner dissolved and its affairs wound up in accordance with its Articles of Organization or Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The nature of the business of the Limited Liability Company and its objects, purposes and powers are:

- (a) To assist people such as elderly, senior citizens, handicapped impaired or people with transportation needs whereas they may not have the costly resources available and to assist with medical appointments, rehabilitation, mental health, day treatments appointments, dialysis, etc., to provide service to areas of the majority that do not have transportation with much needed assistance.
 - (b) Our vision and goal is to provide equipped transportation to all metropolitan areas to all people that need transportation so desperately.
- (c) To purchase or sell, hypothecate, mortgage, and lease such real and personal property as may be necessary for the purposes of the corporation, and to execute deeds,



contracts, agreements and obligations, the purposes whereof are consonant with the laws of the State of Alabama under which this company is formed, and to accept and execute any trust, the purpose whereof is lawful under said laws and consistent with purposes of this company; and to do each everything necessary, suitable, or proper for this accomplishment of any of the purposes herein enumerated, or which may at any time appear conductive or expedient of the benefit or protection of this limited liability company.

- (d) This Limited Liability Company shall have no capital stock, no dividends shall ever be declared or profits distributed, and no part of the net earnings of the company shall be distributed to, trustee, director or individual. The company shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation.
- (e) There shall be only on class of members of the company, being duly admitted to the membership in the Helping Hands Transportation Services, LLC. in accordance with the practice of that entity/company.

The enumeration herein of the powers, objects and purposes of the Limited Liability Company shall not be deemed to exclude or in any way limit by inference any powers, objects or purposes which the Limited Liability Company is empowered to exercise, whether expressly by purpose or by any of the laws of the State of Alabama or any reasonable construction of such laws.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTERED AGENT/OFFICE

The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Limited Liability Company shall be 3024 Stone creek Trace, and its registered agent at such address shall be Kimberly R. Crum.

ARTICLE V

MEMBERS

The name and address of the initial sole member (the "Member" and all of the members collectively, the "Members") of the Limited Liability Company is:



ARTICLE VII

OPERATING AGREEMENT

The Operating Agreement of the Limited Liability Company, if one is adopted, shall be executed by each Member of the Limited Liability Company and shall set forth all provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Limited Liability Company and the conduct of its business to the extent that such provisions are not inconsistent with the laws of Alabama or these Articles. The Operating Agreement may include, without limitation, provisions regarding members, company capital, allocations, distributions, management of the company, transfer of interest, dissolution, accounting and records, the tax matters partner and indemnification. Those provisions together with any other provisions included in the Operating Agreement are hereby incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE VIII

DISSOLUTION CAUSED BY CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The cessation of membership of one or more Members for any reason shall not cause the dissolution of the Limited Liability Company.

ARTICLE IX

MANAGEMENT

Management is vested in the Members of the Limited Liability Company.
