2. The following amendment was adopted in the manner prescribed in the Alabama Business Corporation Act in order to facilitate the name change from Student Life Equipment, Inc. to Echo 2820, Inc.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Echo 2820, Inc.

3. This amendment was adopted by the shareholders and directors in the manner prescribed by law on September 3, 2009.

4. One hundred percent (100%) of the outstanding shares of the Corporation voted in favor of the amendment.
