

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

BUCKHAVEN WHITETAIL BREEDERS, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

Pursuant to the provisions of Ala. Code, Section 10-12-1, et seq. (this act as amended from time to time is referred to herein as the "Act"), the undersigned hereby adopts the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the Limited Liability Company shall be: Buckhaven Whitetail Breeders, Limited Liability Company.

ARTICLE TWO

PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of duration of the Limited Liability Company is unlimited from the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE

The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the purposes of commercial farming of whitetail deer and other activities associated with the purchase, development, collection, marketing, etc. including activities of any lawful business for which a limited liability company may be organized.

ARTICLE FOUR

ARTICLE SEVEN

CONTINUATION AFTER AND EVENT OF DISSOCIATION

The Limited Liability Company shall dissolve upon the death, retirement, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of any of the Members of the Limited Liability Company unless there is at least one remaining member(s) and/or the business of the Limited Liability Company is continued within ninety (90) days after the occurrence of the event of dissolution as permitted by the Act, these Articles, and the Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE EIGHT
