KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$142,500.00) and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned Grantors, **AUDRA McDONOUGH NIUMATA and PETER P. NIUMATA, wife and husband** (hereinafter referred to as Grantors), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Grantors do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Grantees, **GERALD IRWIN and MAY IRWIN** (hereinafter referred to as Grantees), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, their heirs and assigns, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 729, according to the Survey of Savannah Pointe Sector VII, as recorded in Map Book 31, page 101, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

\$142,500.00 of the above-recited consideration is being paid in cash.


Subject to easements, restrictions, rights-of-way, setback lines, covenants, agreements, and mineral/mining rights, if any, of record.


