## DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, which are intended to constitute a Durable Power of Attorney that I, Joseph V. Cicio, Jr., do hereby make, constitute and appoint my daughter, Rose Ann Caiola, as my true lawful Attorney-in-Fact, for me and in my name, place and stead, and on my behalf and for my use and benefit.

To exercise or preform any act, power, duty, right or obligation whatsoever that we now have, or may hereafter acquire legal right, power or capacity to exercise or preform in connection with, arising from, or relating to any person, item, transaction, thing, business property, real or personal, tangible, or whatsoever;

To request, ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, receive and hold and possess all such sums of money, debts, dues, commercial paper, checks, drafts, accounts, deposits, legacies, bequests, devises, noted, interest, stock proceeds, any and all retirement benefits, insurance benefits and proceeds, any and all documents of title, chooses in action, personal, and real property, tangible and intangible property and property rights, and demands whatsoever, liquidated or unliquidated, as now are, or shall hereafter become, owned by me or due, owing, parable or belonging to me or in which I have or may hereafter acquire interest, to have, use, and take all lawful means and equitable and legal remedies, procedures and writs in my name for the collecton and recovery thereof, and to adjust, sell, compromise, and agree for the same, and to make, execute, and deliver for me, on my behalf, and in my name, all endorsements, acquaintances, releases, receipts, or other sufficient discharges for the same;

To lease, purchase, exchange and acquire, and to agree to, bargain, and contract for the lease purchase, exchange, and bargain of, and to accept, take, receive and possess any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or intangible, or interest thereon, on such terms and conditions, and under such convenants, as my said Attorney-in Fact shall deem proper;

To maintain, repair, improve, manage, and acquire, and to agree bargain, and contract for the leases, purchase, exchange, and acquisition of, and to liens, mortgage, subject to deeds of trust, and hypothecate, and in any way or manner deal with all or any part of any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or hereafter acquire, for me, on behalf, and in my name and under such terms and conditions, and under such convenants, as my said Attorney-in-Fact shall deem proper;

I am hereby granting to my said Attorney-in-Fact the right to execute any and all necessary documents for selling of any real property which I may acquire in the future and giving my Attorney-in-Fact the right to acquire real estate in my name and in my stead and to execute any and all business and management with respect to said property.

To conduct, engage in, and transact any and all lawful business of whatever nature or kind for me, on behalf, and in my name;

To make, receive, sign, endorse, execute, acknowledge, deliver, and possess such application, contracts agreements, options, convenants, conveyance, deeds, trust deeds, security, agreements, bills of sale, lease, mortgages, assignments, insurance policies, bills of lading, warehouse receipts, documents of title, bills bonds, debentures, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, letter of credit, notes, stock certificates, proxies, warrants, commercial paper, receipts, withdrwal receipts and deposit certificates of deposit of banks, saving and loan associations, credit unions, or other financial institutions or associations, proofs of loss, evidences of debts, releases, and satisfaction of mortgages, liens, judgements, security agreements and other debts and obligations and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the exercise of the rights and powers herein granted;

To enter safe deposit boxes, place name of Attorney-in-Fact on all records of account, to close accounts, to change certificate of deposit as my Attorney-in-Fact sees fit. To remove all contents at any banking institutions from any safe deposit box.

I grant to my said Attorney-in-Fact full power and authority to sign, and endorse checks on any of my bank accounts or on my behalf, including withdrawal of any funds from any of my bank accounts.

I grant to my said Attorney-in-Fact full power and authority to do take and perform all and every act and thing whats ever required, proper, or necessary to be done, in the exercise of any of the rights and powers herein granted, as fully to all intents and purposes as we might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney-in-Fact, or her substitutes, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this Durable Power of Attorney and the rights and powers herein granted.

This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a Durable Power of Attorney. The enumeration of specific items, rights, acts, or powers herein is not intended, nor does it limit or restrict, and is not to be construed or interpreted as limiting or restricting, the general powers hereby granted to my said Attorney-in-Fact.

The rights, powers and authority of my said Attorney-in-Fact herein granted shall commence and be in full force immediately; the authority conferred herein shall not be affected by disability, incompetency, or incapacity of the said principal, Joseph V. Cicio, Jr., individually, separately and severally; and such rights, powers, and authority shall remain in full force and effect until the death of the principal. Any action taken in good faith pursuant to the foregoing authority without actual knowledge of my death shall be binding upon me, my heirs, assigns and personal representatives.
