

## **ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION**

### **ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF DOG DAYS OF BIRMINGHAM, L.L.C.**

Pursuant to the Provisions of Section 10-12-1, *et seq.* of the Code of Alabama (1975), the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization.

#### ARTICLE I

##### Name

The name of the limited liability company is Dog Days of Birmingham, L.L.C.

#### ARTICLE II

##### Duration

The Company shall have a perpetual duration from the date of organization, unless it is dissolved and its affairs wound up in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the “Act”).

#### ARTICLE III

##### Purposes

The purposes for which the Company is formed are:

- (a) Dog boarding services.
- (b) To engage in any other lawful act or activity for which limited liability companies may be organized pursuant to the Act.

#### ARTICLE IV

##### Registered Office; Registered Agent


