

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF BOYD & BINKLEY SERVICES, LLC

The undersigned, acting as the organizers of a limited liability company under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the Act), hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for Boyd & Binkley Services, LLC (the Company).

ARTICLE I

The name of the Company shall be Boyd & Binkley Services, LLC.

ARTICLE II

The Company shall continue in existence until it is dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the operating agreement, or, if there is no operating agreement or no provision in the operating agreement governing the duration of the Company, then in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act.

ARTICLE III

The Company has been organized for the following purpose:

- (1) To provide training to home inspectors and other individuals in the use of infrared thermography and other related technologies for the purpose of conducting energy audits on commercial and residential properties and to otherwise engage in any lawful act or activity.
- (2) To enter into, make and perform contracts and agreements of every kind for any lawful purpose with any person, firm, company, municipality, or political body, whether related to the business purpose stated in ¶ l above or not, and generally to carry on any and every lawful business which a Limited Liability Company is permitted to do by the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama; and such other business shall not be limited to the State of Alabama; and
- (3) In furtherance of and not limited by any of the aforesaid objects, to carry on any lawful business, to sell all types of goods and perform all types of services, and to do anything convenient in connection with the carrying on of such business; and to do business without any restrictions in any legal business in the State of Alabama, or any other state of the United States, and to own, buy and sell personal

property and to borrow money and issue its bonds, notes or mortgages therefore.

ARTICLE IV

The location and street address of the initial registered office of the Company shall be 2525 Elizabeth Drive, Pelham, Alabama 35124, and its registered agent at such address shall be Michael J. Boyd.

ARTICLE V

Other offices for the transacting of business shall be located at such places as the business of the Company may require.

ARTICLE VI

The names and addresses of the initial Members of the Company are:

ARTICLE VII

The initial Members shall have the right to admit additional Members upon unanimous consent and agreement of the original Members.

ARTICLE VIII

All meetings of the Members of the Company shall be held at the principal office of the Company or at such other place as may be legally designated by the Members.

The annual meeting of the Members of the Company shall be held at 2525 Elizabeth Drive, Pelham, Alabama 35124 on the 31st of December of each year unless such day be a legal holiday, in which case the meeting shall be held at the same time on the next succeeding day not a legal holiday.

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A special meeting of the Members of the Company may be called at any time by the Members. It shall be the duty of the Members to call a special meeting of the Members whenever so requested by Members holding 25% or more in interest of the capital of the Company.

Notice of the time, place and purpose of all meetings of the Members, regular and special, shall be mailed at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the meeting by the Secretary to each Member of record at his, her or its address. Notwithstanding the failure to give notice as hereinbefore provided, any meeting shall be a legal meeting for the transaction of all business if each Member is either present, in person or by proxy, or has in writing waived such notice.

Except as may otherwise be provided by law, a majority of the capital entitled to vote and outstanding, represented in person or by proxy by Member of record, shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of Members, but the Members present at any such meeting, in person or by proxy, though less than a quorum, may adjourn the meeting to a future time and the adjourned meeting may be held at such time without further notice.

Each Member shall be entitled to one vote for each dollar of capital held by him, her or it, which vote shall be cast either in person or by written proxy filed with the Secretary of the meeting prior to being voted. Such proxy shall entitle the holder thereof to vote at any adjournment of such meeting, but shall not be valid after the final adjournment thereof unless provided to the contrary herein.

All Company powers shall be exercised by or under authority of the Members and the property of the Company shall be under the direction of the Members.

ARTICLE IX

The legal existence and business of the Company may be continued by the written consent of all the remaining Members within 90 days after an event of dissociation of a Member.

ARTICLE X

The funds of the Company shall be deposited in such banks and trust companies as the Members shall designate. All orders for the payment of money, notes and other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Members shall designate the members, agent or agents of the Company signing as authorized by the Members.
