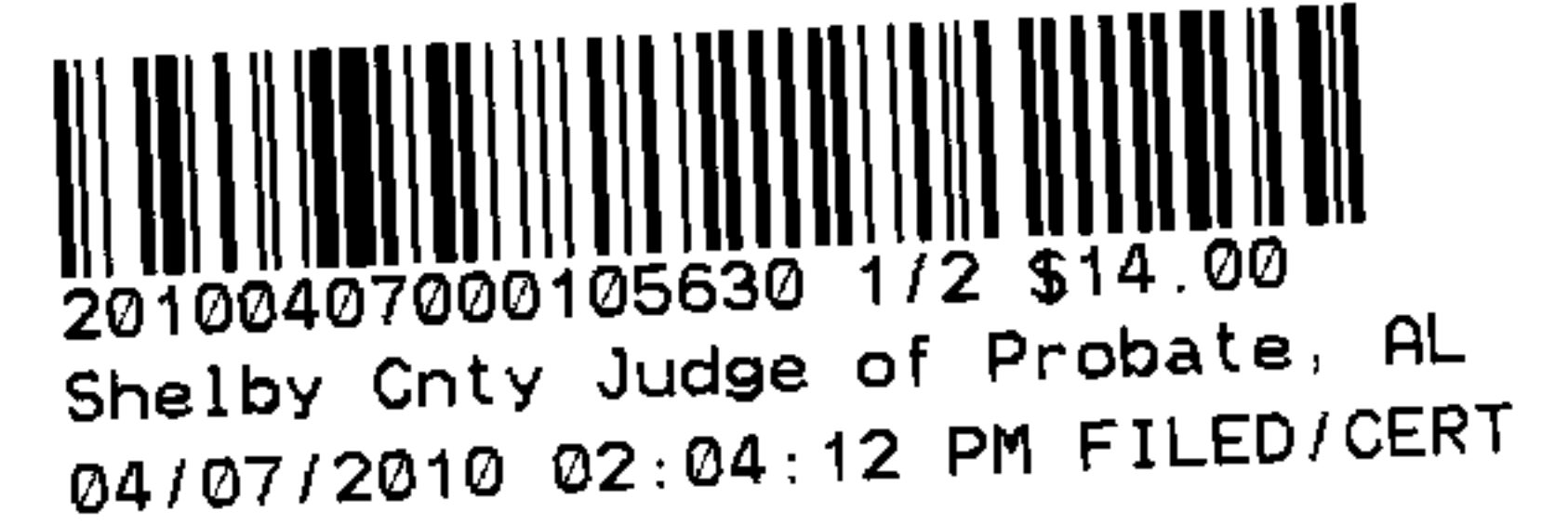

DURABLE SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, Christine M. Brown, do hereby appoint Robert J. This Power of Attorney is granted for a period of 180 days and shall become effective on the 29th day of March, 2010, and shall terminate one hundred eighty (180) days thereafter.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by my disability, incompetency or incapacity.
