ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

THE LASSITER GROUP, L.L.C.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under Title 10, Chapter 12 of the Code of Alabama (1975), as amended (the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act), hereby file the following Articles of Organization with the Probate Judge of the county in which the initial registered agent of the limited liability company will be located and affirm that the facts stated in the Articles of Organization are true and correct.


ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the limited liability company is THE LASSITER GROUP, L.L.C. (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").

ARTICLE II
DURATION

The period and duration of the Company shall be from the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization with the Office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama until the first to occur of the following:

- (a) Dissolution of the Company pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama or the operating agreement of the Company, as in effect from time to time; or
- (b) Upon the written unanimous consent of all members of the Company.


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ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

(a) From time to time to apply for, purchase, or acquire by assignment, transfer, or otherwise, and to exercise, carry out, and enjoy license, power, authority, franchise, concession, right, or privilege that any government or authority, Federal, State, or local or any corporation or any other legal entity may be empowered to enact, make or grant and to pay for, aid in, and contribute toward carrying it into effect and to appropriate any of the company's stocks, bonds, and assets to defray the necessary costs, charges and expenses thereof.

(b) To maintain, control, and operate a pool tournament(s), event(s), club and/or pool hall, conduct a pool tournament(s), event(s), club and/or pool hall, games, exhibitions and places of amusement and recreation for the general public; to acquire, hold and operate, and dispose of any and all privileges, rights, franchises, and concessions; and to buy, sell lease, mortgage, and exchange any and all real and personal property which may be necessary, advantageous, or proper in the conduct of its business,

(c) To buy, sell, lease, and rent any real property whether developed or undeveloped.

(d) To do any and all things herein set out and such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects and purposes of this corporation, to the same extent as natural persons might or could do and in any part of the world, as principle, factor, agent, contractor, or otherwise either alone or in conduction with any person, firm, association, corporation or any entity of whatsoever kind, and to do any and all such acts and things and to exercise any and all such powers and engage in the transactions of any and all lawfully business to



full extent authorized or permitted to a corporation under any laws that may be now or hereafter applicable or available to this corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV
REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Company shall be 1414 Molly's Place, Alabaster, Al. 35007, and the names of the initial registered agent at such address shall be Herschel O. Lassiter, Jr.

ARTICLE V
INITIAL MEMBERS

ARTICLE VII
EFFECT OF CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The cessation of membership of one or more members will not result in the dissolution of the Company except as provided in the Company's Operating Agreement and/or as required by applicable law.
