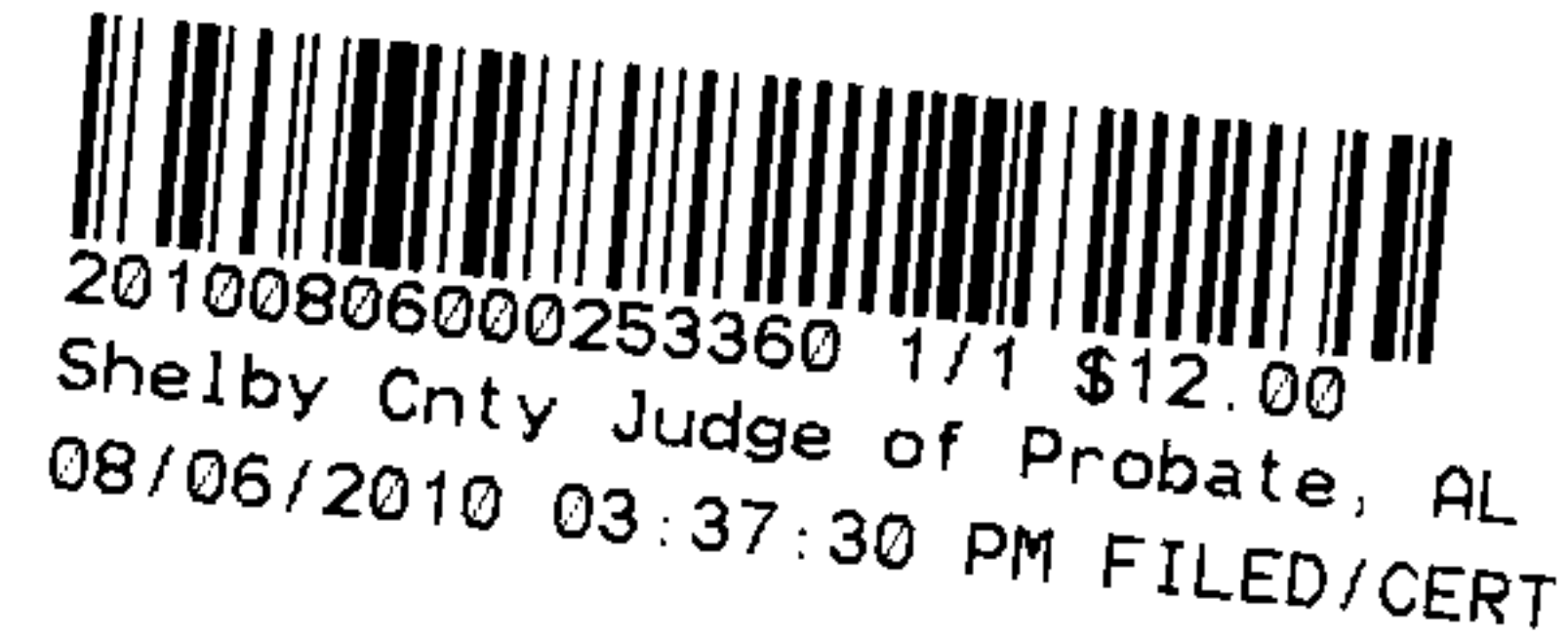

That said, High Hampton Residential Association, Inc. claims a lien upon the following property, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:


Lot 16 according to the survey of High Hampton as recorded in Map Book 26, page 47, in the office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

The name of the owner of the said property is James Russell Coston.


