

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared Betty Jean Shinn, who, after first being duly sworn, deposed and stated as follows:

My name is Betty Jean Shinn. I am licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama, and have practiced law in the State since 1996. I am giving this affidavit for the purpose of correcting the legal description in that certain mortgage (the "Mortgage") dated July 30, 2002, from Mary Bass Johnson to Betty Jean Shinn (the affiant), recorded in Instrument #20030909000602950 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

The Mortgage was prepared by an office assistant at my direction. A mistake in typing resulted in "Lot 65A" being included in the legal description of the mortgaged property. The mistake was the omission of a dash and the numeral two ("-2") following "Lot 65A." The omission resulted in Lot 65A being erroneously covered by the Mortgage.

The Mortgagor did not own Lot 65A, and I, as Mortgagee, was entitled to an interest in Lot 65A-2, only. The correct legal description for the Mortgage is shown on Exhibit A.

I have no interest in or claim to Lot 65A-1.

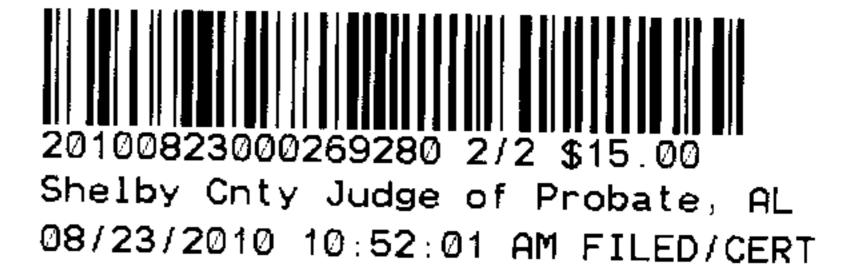


EXHIBIT "A"
