**FORECLOSURE DEED**

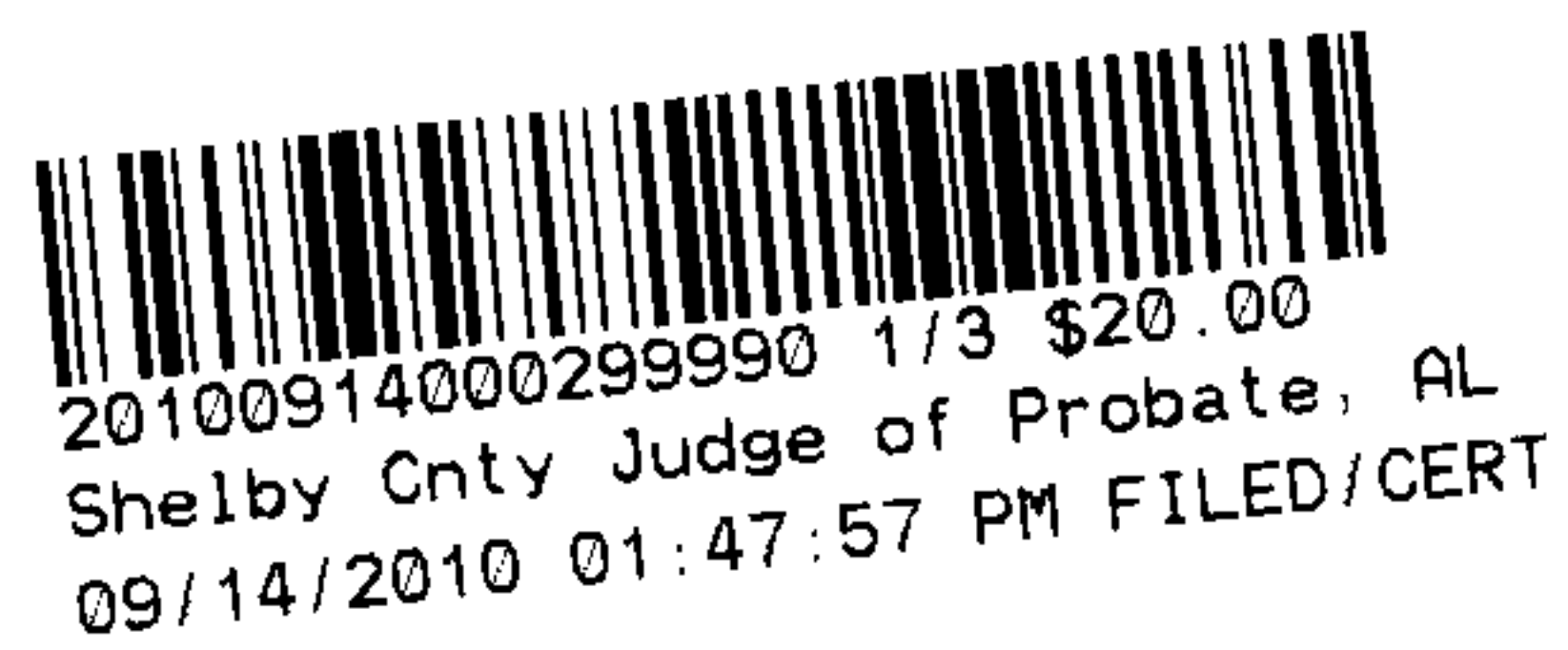
**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS**, that, whereas, heretofore on to-wit: the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2008, Alfred W. Clark, Jr. and wife, Janice D. Clark, did execute a certain mortgage on property herein described to Superior Bank, which said mortgage is recorded as Document Number 20080331000129610 in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

**WHEREAS**, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, the day on which the foreclosure sale was to be held under the terms of said notice between the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure was duly and properly conducted and Superior Bank did offer for sale and sell at public outcry in front of the Courthouse door in Shelby County, Alabama, the property hereinafter described:

**WHEREAS**, Thomas R. Wolfe was the Auctioneer who conducted the said foreclosure sale and was the person conducting the sale for Superior Bank, and



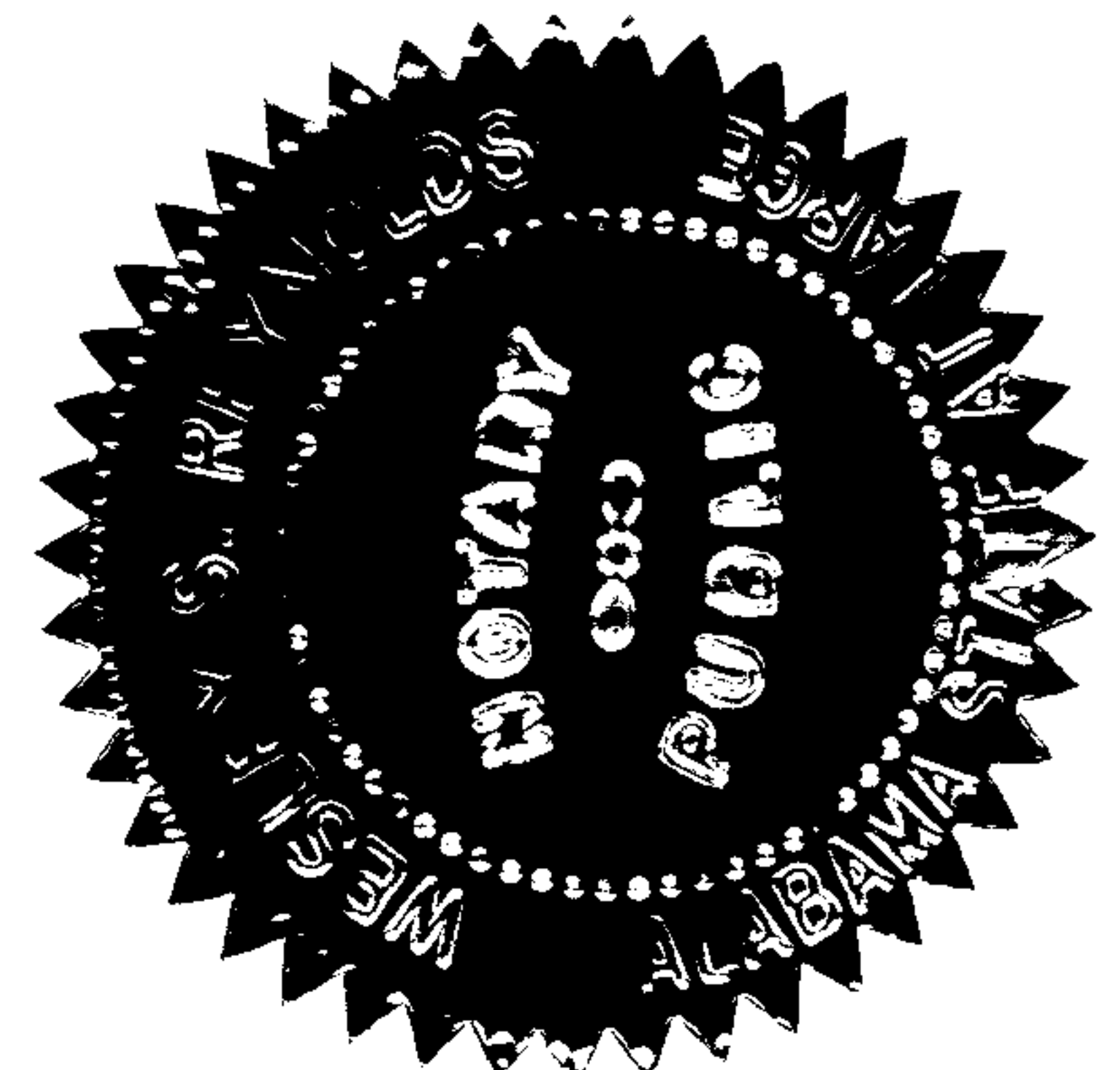
