(herein referred to as Grantees) as individual owner or as joint tenants, with right of survivorship,  
if more than one, the following described real estate, situated in the State of Alabama, County of  
Shelby, to-wit:

**Lot 33, according to the Final Plat of Subdivision, North Lake at Greystone, Phase 3, as recorded in Map Book 23  
page 3 the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.**

**Together with the nonexclusive easement to use the private roadways, Common Areas and Hugh Daniel Drive, all as  
more particularly described in the Greystone Farms North Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions
