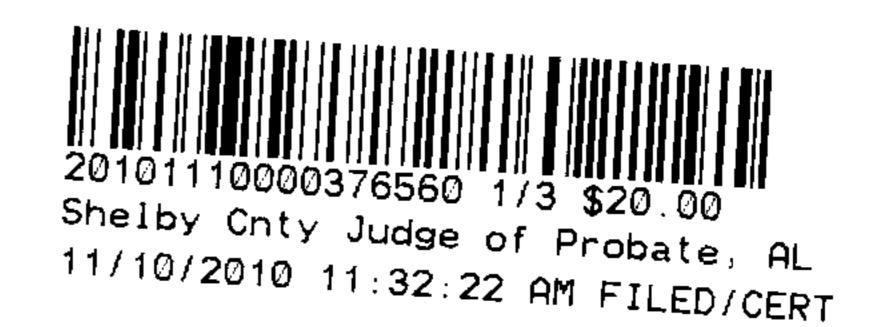

SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this <u>29th day of October</u>, <u>2010</u>, by and between <u>Robert G. Durough and Bonita Durough</u>, (hereinafter called "Mortgagors"), and <u>Superior Bank</u>, (hereinafter called "Mortgagee").

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the Mortgagors desire to refinance a mortgage on property located in Shelby County, Alabama and to enter into and execute a mortgage in favor of <u>Superior Bank</u> in the principal amount of <u>\$417,000.00</u> to be dated <u>October 29, 2010</u>. Said parcel of property being located in Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 508 according to the Survey of Greystone Legacy 5th Sector, Phase II, as recorded in Map Book 32, pages 85 A & B, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Whereas, it is the intent and desire of the Mortgagors and Mortgagee that the aforesaid Mortgages in favor of the Mortgagee be subordinated in all respects to the mortgage to be executed by the Mortgagors in favor of Superior Bank in the principal amount of \$417,000.00 to be dated October 29, 2010.
