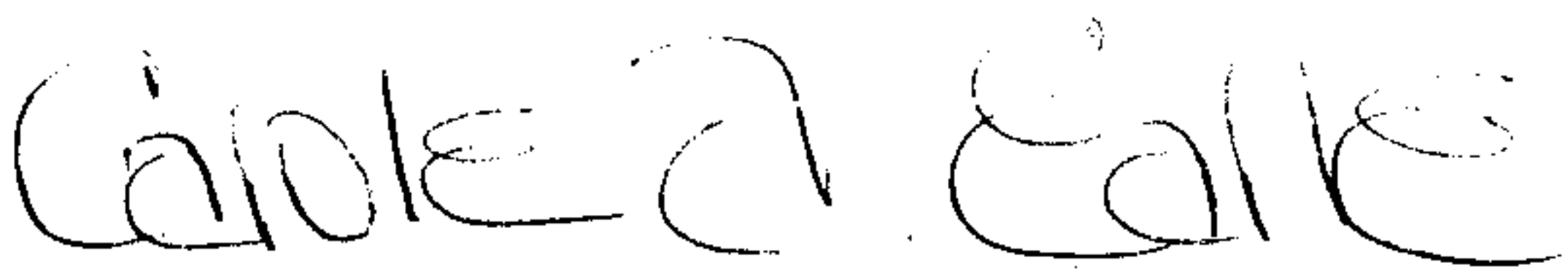
The Trust has not been revoked, modified or amended in any manner that would cause the representations contained herein to be incorrect.

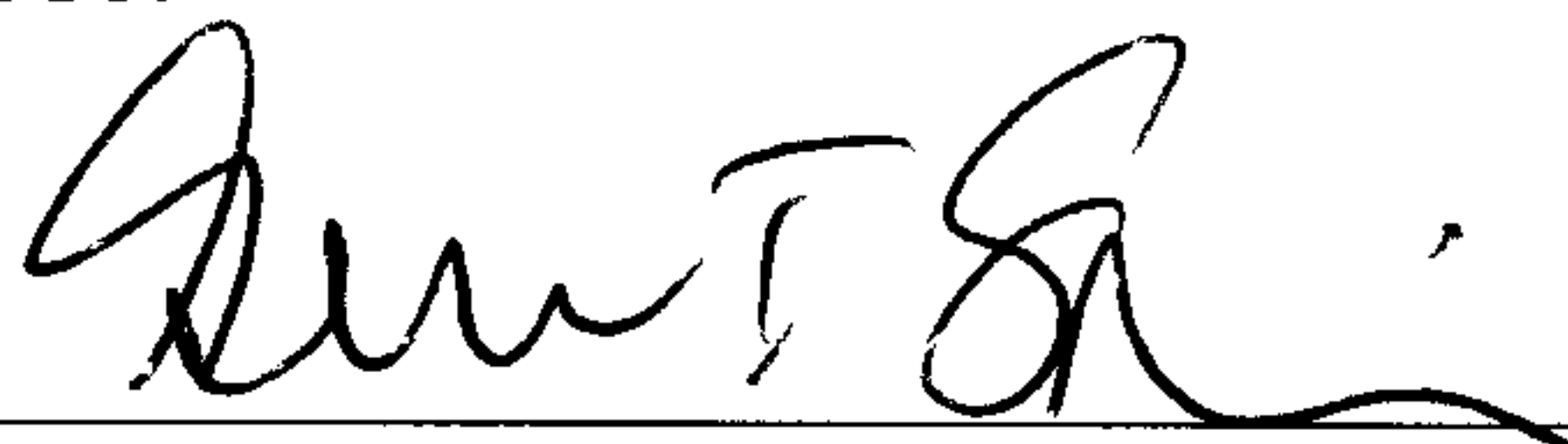
