## DOMESTIC FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION


INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: File original and two copies with the Judge of Probate in the county where the original Articles of Incorporation are filed with Secretary of State and Judge of Probate fees attached. The Judge of Probate's filing fee is \$10 and the Secretary of State's filing fee is \$20.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Business Corporation Act, the undersigned for-profit corporation submits the following Articles of Dissolution.

Article I	The name of the corporation: Limemick Enterprises Inc.
Article II	The dissolution was authorized on Ochober 10, 2010, 2010.
Article III	The total number of shareholder votes entitled to be cast is $2$ . The number of shareholder votes for the dissolution was $2$ and the number of shareholder votes against the dissolution was $4$ .
Article IV	If voting by groups, the information required by <b>Article III</b> above must be separately provided for each group entitled to vote.
Article V	If the dissolution was approved by written consent of all shareholders, a statement to that effect may be substituted for requirements in <i>Articles III &amp; IV</i> above when a copy of such signed consent is attached.
