

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
INSITE ASSET MANAGEMENT, LLC

The undersigned, being the initial members of INSITE ASSET MANAGEMENT, LLC, a limited liability company formed pursuant to Section 10-12-1 et. seq., of the Code of Alabama, hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization for said company:

FIRST, The name of the company shall be INSITE ASSET MANAGEMENT, LLC.

SECOND: The term of the company shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and shall continue for a period of ninety-nine (99) years thereafter; provided, however, that the company shall be dissolved prior to such date (a) upon the unanimous written consent of the holders of the portion of the ownership interest of the company specified in the Operating Agreement, as amended from time to time; (b) as provided in the Operating Agreement, as amended from time to time; or (c) as may be required by the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, as amended from time to time.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the Company is organized are (a) to acquire, own, purchase, develop, invest in, deal in and with, hold, subdivide, manage, sell, operate, convey, lease and sublease all kinds of real and personal property of any nature whatsoever; (b) to borrow money and issue notes and other evidence of indebtedness, and to secure the payment and performance of its obligations thereunder by mortgage, deeds of trust, pledge or otherwise, and (c) to engage in any other business or activity now or hereafter permitted by law.

FOURTH: The address of the initial registered office of the company is 100 Chase Park South, Suite 200, Hoover, Alabama 35244. The name of the initial registered agent at such address is Bryan K. Pate.

FIFTH: The names and addresses of the initial members of the company shall be as follows:

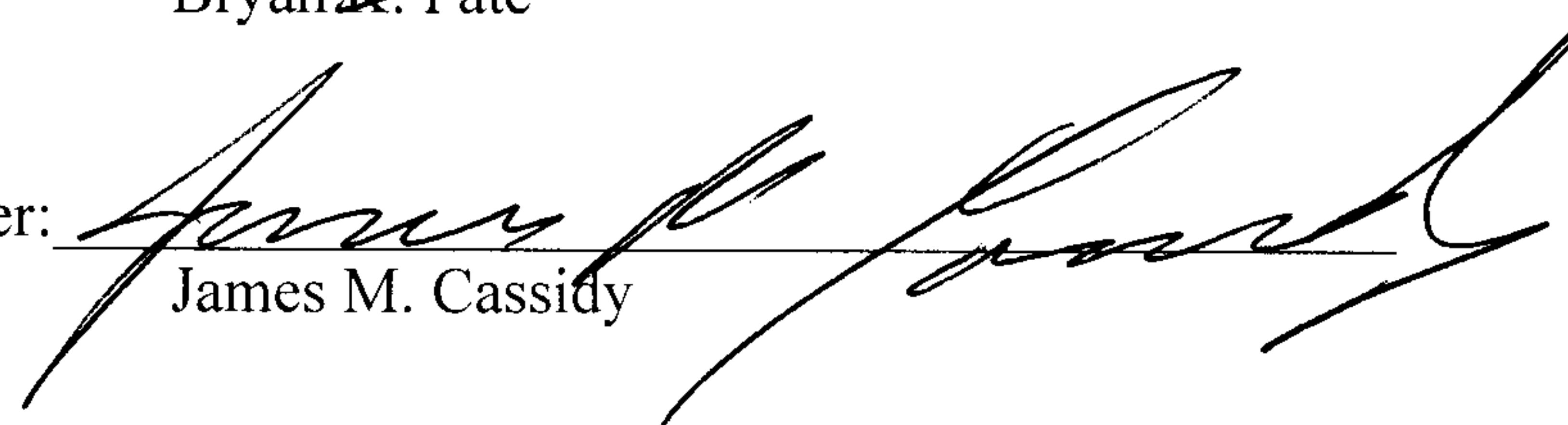
SIXTH: The members shall have the right to admit additional members, upon such terms and conditions as set forth in the Operating Agreement, as amended from time to time.
