

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF JAMES T. SHIRLEY, LLC

Pursuant to the Provisions of §10-12-1, et. Seq. of the Code of Alabama (1975 as amended), the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the limited liability company is James T. Shirley, LLC (the "Company").

ARTICLE II

Duration

The Company shall have a duration from the date of organization and shall continue perpetually, unless it is dissolved and its affairs wound up in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act").

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The Company is formed for the purpose of:

- (a) Consulting and advising on financial matters, and placing and managing funds for investment;
- (b) Any other legal business activity required to offer legal services to the general public;
- (c) Protecting the various assets and properties of the Company from the claims of creditors of the Members;
- (d) Protecting the various assets and properties of the Members from the claims of creditors of the Company;
- (e) Carrying on any and all activities necessary, proper, convenient, or advisable in connection therewith; and,
- (f) Undertaking any other lawful business activity, except as otherwise provided by the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE IV

Registered Office; Registered Agent

The location and street address of the initial registered office of the Company shall be 107 Meadowcroft Circle, Birmingham, AL 35242 and its registered agent at such address shall be James T. Shirley.

Admission of Additional Members


Upon the unanimous written consent of the members, the Company may permit the admission of additional members and the terms and conditions of their admission shall be set forth in the Company's Operating Agreement.
