DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

I. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, **ANN TAYLOR**, the Principal, of the City of Birmingham, County of Jefferson, State of Alabama, hereby make, constitute and appoint **my daughter, LISA CARR**, my true and lawful Attorney in Fact for me and in my name, place and stead, giving unto said **LISA CARR**, full power to do and perform all and every act that I may legally do through an Attorney in Fact, and every proper power necessary to carry out the purposes for which this Power is granted, and, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying that which **LISA CARR**, or her lawful substitute shall do or cause to be done by herself or her substitute lawfully designated by virtue of the power herein conferred upon them.

II. PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ALABAMA CODE OF 1975, TITLE 26, SECTION 1, SUB-SECTION 2, AS AMENDED BY THE ACTS OF 1981, NUMBER 81-89 AT PAGE 117- THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED BY DISABILITY, INCOMPETENCY OR INCAPACITY OF THE PRINCIPAL.

III. In the event this Durable Power of Attorney has been executed by Principal and delivered to the Attorney in Fact, **it shall not become operative and take effect until the earlier to occur of the following: (i) Principal's delivery to the Attorney in Fact of written instructions to so act, or (ii) Principal's disability, incompetency or incapacity, as contemplated by the terms of Paragraph IV hereof.**

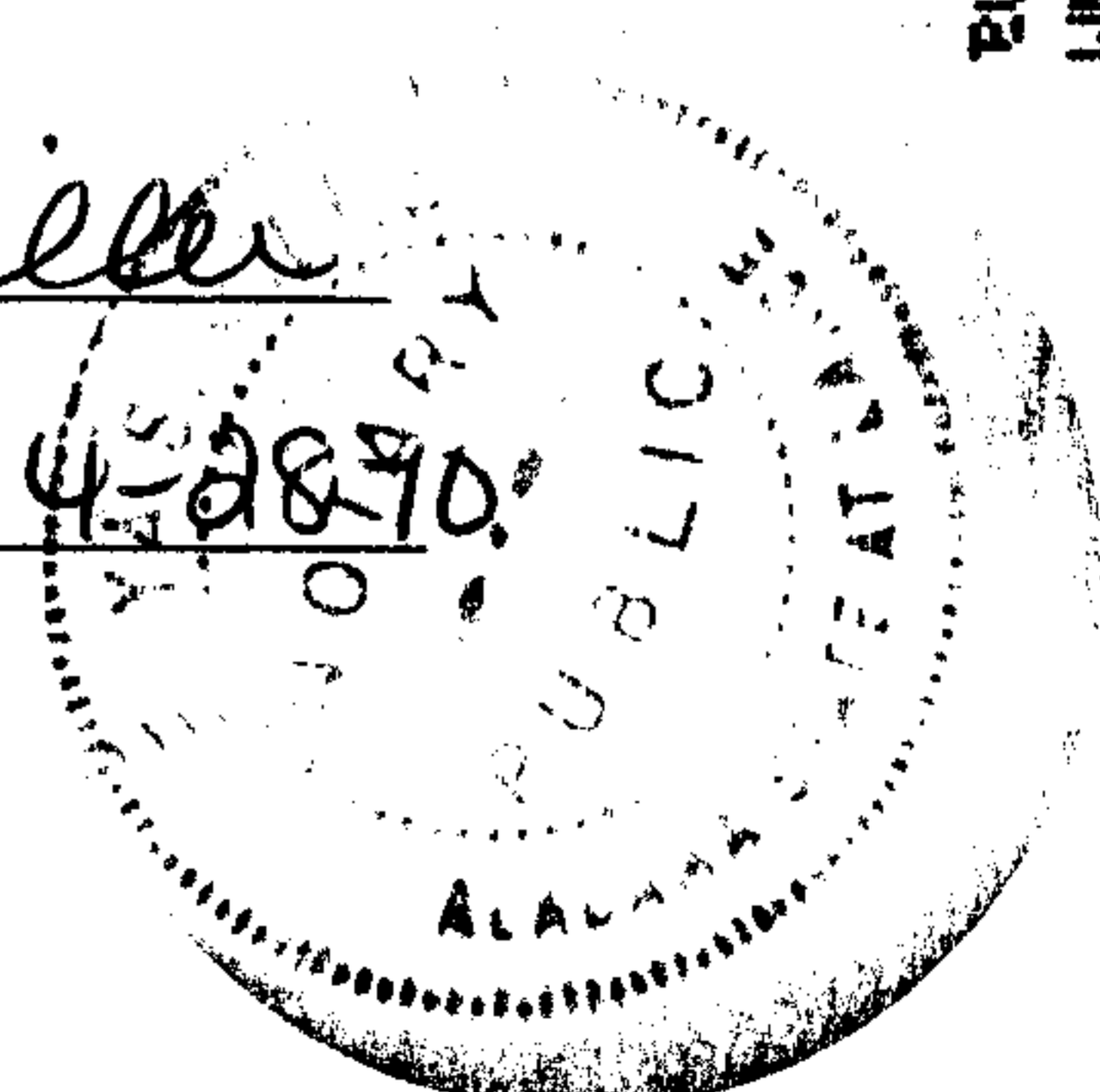
