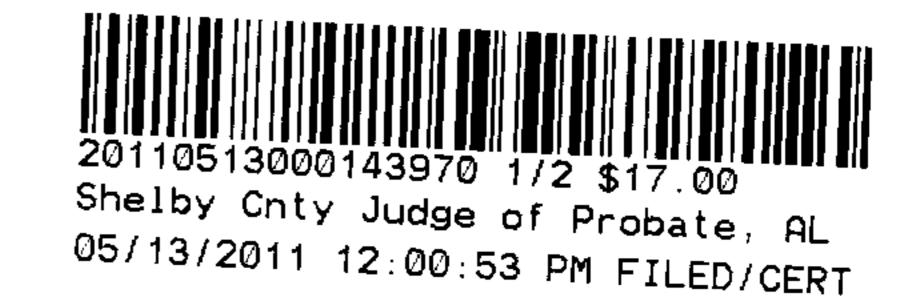
MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE DEED

WHEREAS, heretofore, on to-wit: March 20, 1996 Gerald R. Atchley, a married man, mortgagor, executed a certain mortgage to First Federal Bank, a Federal Savings Bank, said mortgage being recorded in **Instrument No. 1996-09117**, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2011, the day on which the foreclosure sale was due to be held under the terms of said notice between the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure sale was duly and properly conducted, and the First Federal Bank, a Federal Savings Bank, did offer for sale and sell at public outcry, in front of the Courthouse door, Main Entrance, Shelby County, Columbiana, Alabama, the property hereinafter described; and
