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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

IMPERIAL INVESTMENTS, LLC

THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company (the "Company") pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "LLC Act"), does hereby and adopt the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Company is Imperial Investments, LLC (the "Company").

ARTICLE II

The existence of the Company shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and shall be dissolved upon the earlier to occur of (i) the written consent of all the members to dissolve the Company; (ii) as provided by the Operating Agreement; or (iii) as may be required under the LLC Act.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Company is organized are:

- (a) To invest in, acquire, hold, maintain, operate, own, lease, improve, sell, exchange, develop and otherwise use interest in other companies, stocks, real and personal property, whether tangible or intangible, for profit, and to engage in any and all activities related to or incidental thereto;
- (b) To borrow and lend money and to give or take security therefore by way of mortgage, pledge, transfer or assignment of real or personal property, of every nature and description;
- (c) To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit as to amount with any person, firm, association or corporation, town, city, county, state, territory, government or governmental subdivision;



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- (d) To purchase, take, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use and otherwise deal in or with other companies, stock, real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated, and to sell, convey, mortgage, pledges, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of real or personal property, or any interest therein;
- (e) To assume, guarantee or become surety for the payment and performance of any and all debts and obligations of another or others, and to guarantee the payment of dividends upon any security or securities;
- (f) To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the objects herein enumerated or necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the Company, and in general, to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the Company, and in general, to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the attainment of the purposes of the Company, whether such business is similar in nature to the objects and powers hereinabove set forth or otherwise;
- (g) To engage in any lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the LLC Act and the Laws of Alabama, as same now exist or hereinafter be amended.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed as purposes for which the Company is organized, in addition to those specifically conferred upon the Company by law, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing specific enumeration of powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the Company otherwise granted by law.

ARTICLE IV

The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Company is 4997 Heather Point, Birmingham, Alabama 35242, and its registered agent at such address shall be Patrick H. Sutton.

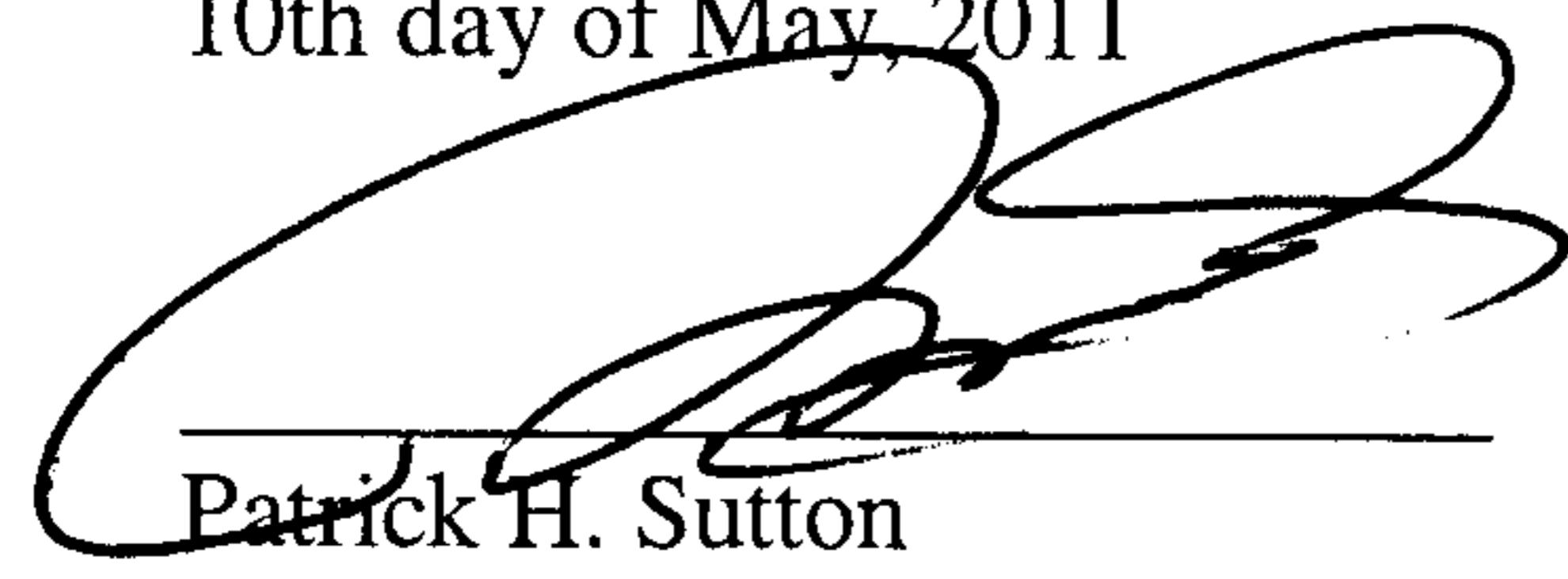


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ARTICLE IX
