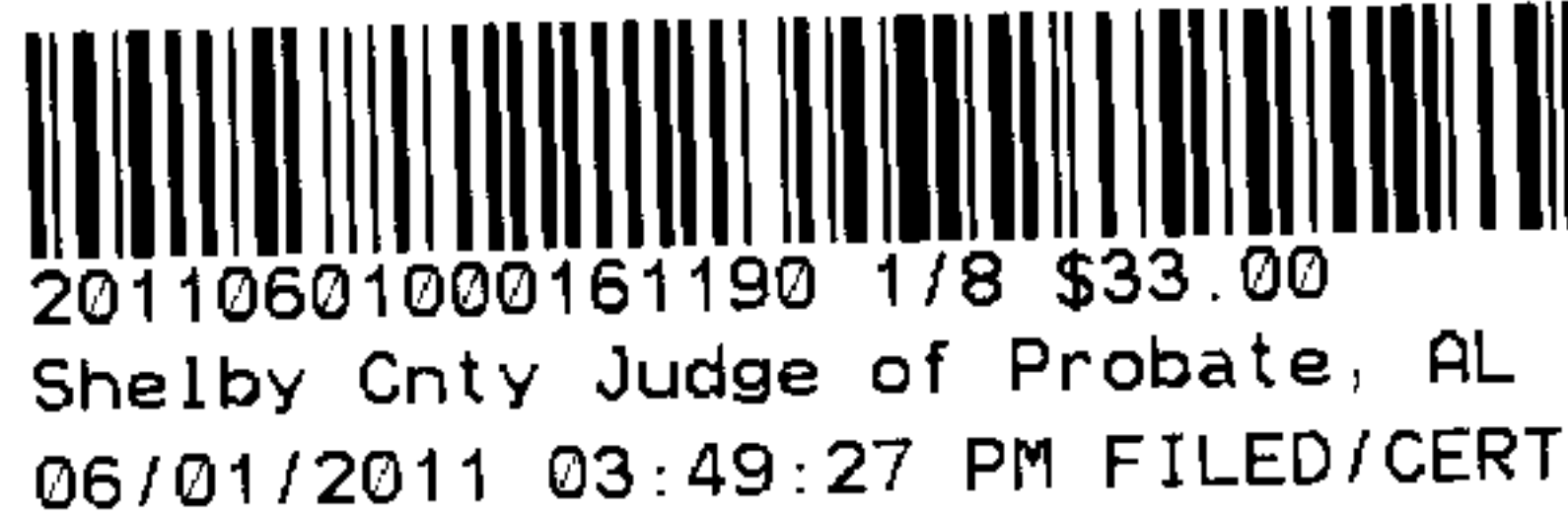

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Era Box O'Neill, of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory and over the age of twenty-one years, and being mindful of the certainty of death and the uncertainty of life, do hereby make, publish and declare this as my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former testamentary dispositions which may have been made heretofore by me.

ITEM ONE:

I hereby direct my Executor, hereinafter named, to pay all of my debts and my funeral expenses, if not otherwise paid, as soon after my death as practical.

ITEM TWO:

I hereby will, devise and bequeath all of my property of every kind, character and description, including all real property and all personal property which I may own at the time of my death, to my beloved husband, Harry E. O'Neill, to be his absolutely and in fee simple forever.

ITEM THREE:

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said husband, Harry E. O'Neill, to be the Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, and I hereby expressly relieve and exempt him from giving any bond for the faithful performance of his duties as such Executor, and I further relieve and exempt him from filing any inventory or making any report as such Executor to any Court of the State of Alabama or of any other State.
