THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company (the "Company") pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "LLC Act"), do hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Company is: MRM MANAGEMENT, LLC

ARTICLE II

The existence of the Company shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama, and shall continue until indefinitely; *provided, however*, that the Company shall be dissolved prior to such date upon the earlier to occur of (i) the written consent of all the members to dissolve the Company; (ii) as provided in the Operating Agreement; or (iii) as may be required under the LLC Act.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Company is organized are:

- (a) to engage in the business of acquiring, owning, developing, improving, operating, leasing, selling, and otherwise dealing in and with improved and unimproved real property directly and indirectly; and

(b) to engage in any lawful act or activity for which limited liability companies may be organized under the LLC Act.

ARTICLE IV

The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Company in the State of Alabama is 3185 Bradford Place Birmingham, AL 35242, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Margaret R. Massey.

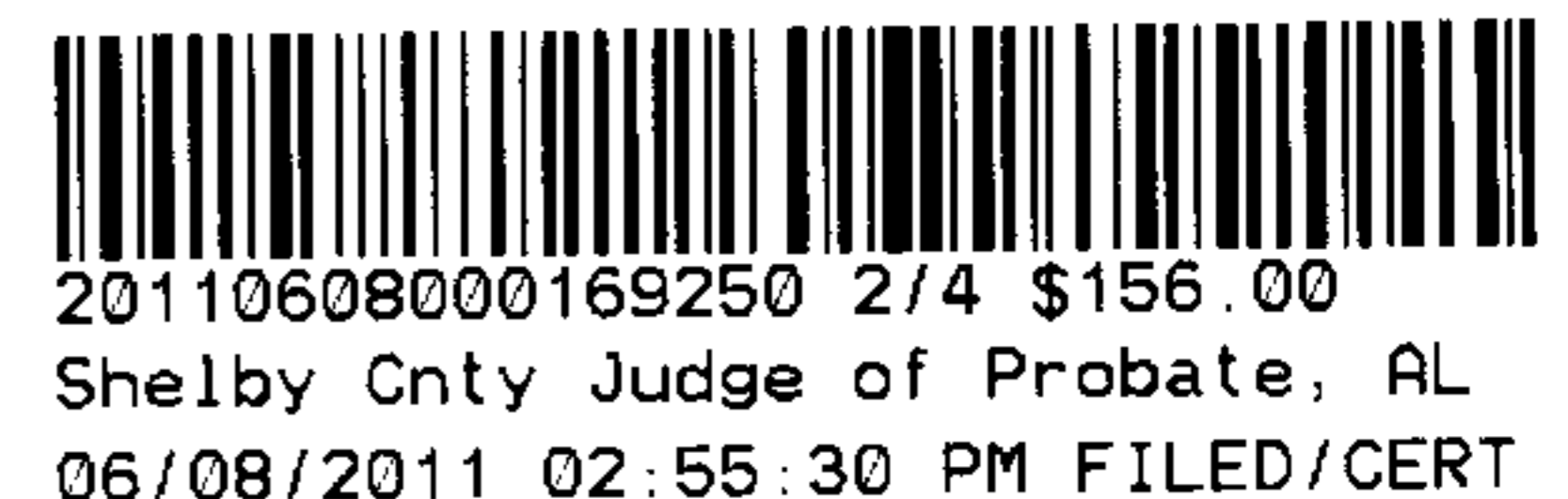

The Company shall admit additional members only upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE VII


The Members of the Company shall have the right to continue its business after an event of dissociation terminates the continued membership of a member in the Company if a new member is immediately

admitted upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Operating Agreement, and the legal existence and business of the Company is continued by the written consent of any other members within 90 days after the occurrence of such event of dissociation.

ARTICLE VIII

The Company shall be managed by a Managing Member. The initial Managing Member is Margaret R. Massey and her address is 3185 Bradford Place Birmingham, Alabama 35242.



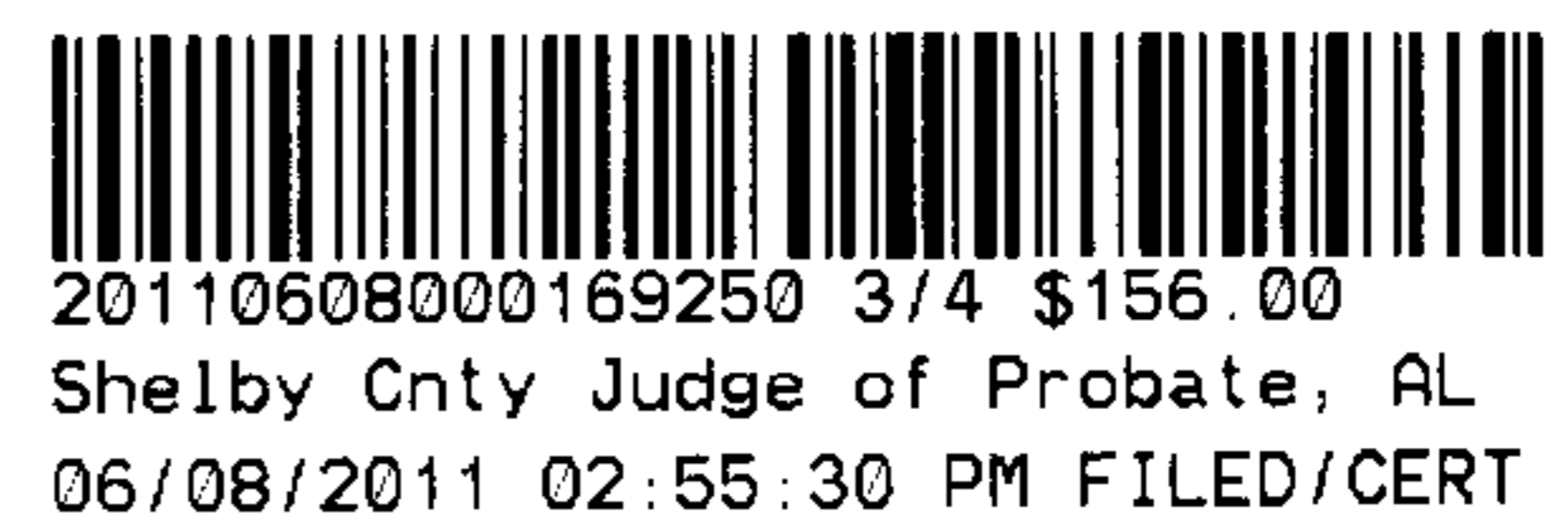
