RIGHT TO CONTINUE

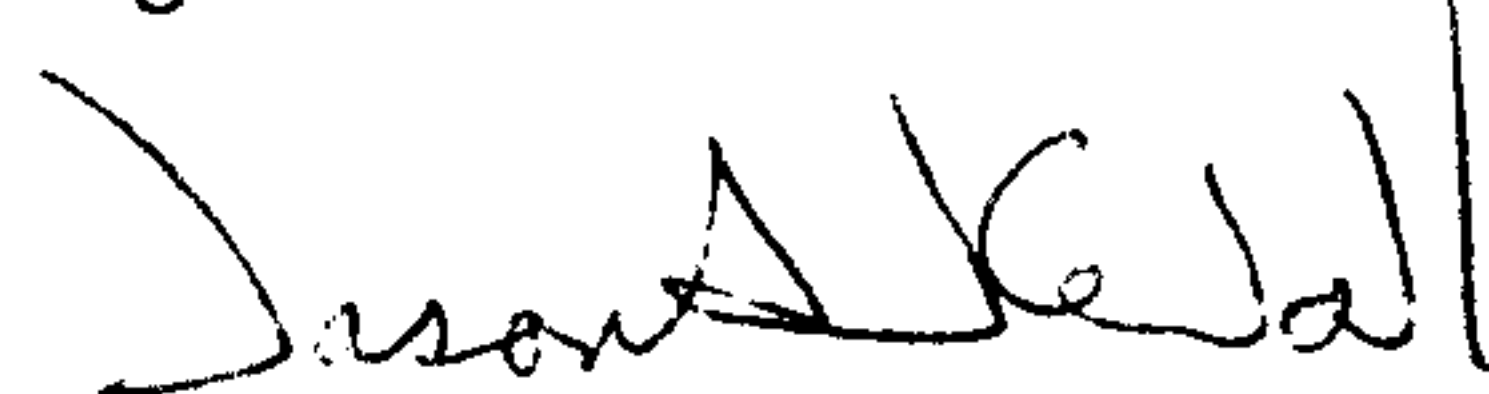
If an event of dissociation terminates the continued membership of a member, the Limited Liability Company shall continue according to the provisions of the operating agreement.

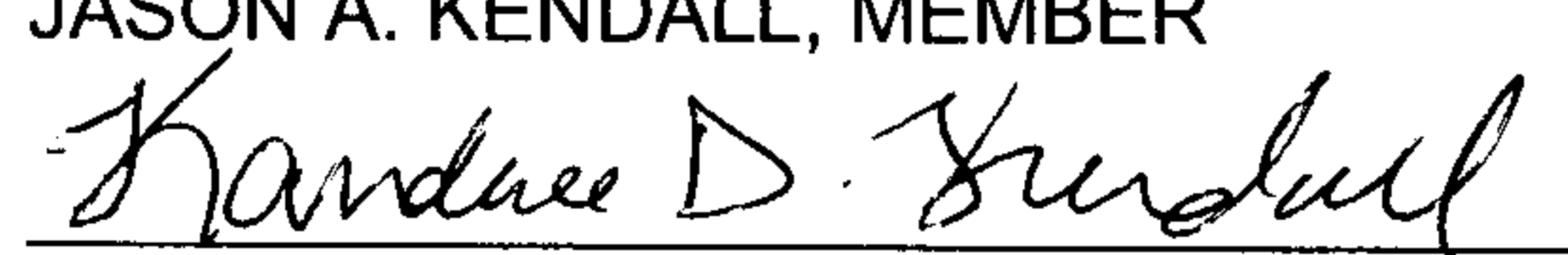
