

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
Vulcan Pumps, LLC,
(AN ALABAMA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY)

Pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama (1975), Section 10A-05-1.01, et seq., the undersigned hereby adopts the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the limited liability company is Vulcan Pumps, LLC (hereinafter referred to as "Company").

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The Company shall have a duration from the date of organization until forty (40) years thereafter, unless it is dissolved and its affairs wound up prior to that date in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Act").

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

Section 3.01 Purpose. This Company is organized with a general business purpose, has all powers provided by law and may use those powers to any lawful purpose, including but not limited to the following purposes: (i) to consolidate assets to reduce operational costs; (ii) to protect the property held by the Company; (iii) to take advantage of the legal and tax flexibilities provided by the limited liability company entity, in general and the Act, in particular; (iv) to invest company assets in accordance with the modern portfolio theory of management, which incorporates the prudent investor rule, instead of under the archaic trust law theory of management, which requires adherence to the prudent investor rule, with potential conflicts between current income and remaindermen beneficiaries; (v) to institutionalize communications among the members; (vi) to provide for an orderly transfer of Membership Interests by members during lifetime and at death; and (vii) to acquire, exchange, own, manage, develop, subdivide, operate, lease, and sell real estate interests, and (viii) to sell, repair, modify, assemble, and install hydraulic and other equipment for industrial applications.

Section 6.02 Powers. The Company shall possess and may exercise all the powers and privileges granted by the Act or by any other law or by its Operating Agreement, together with any powers incidental thereto, so far as such powers and privileges are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the business, purposes or activities of the Company.

DISSOLUTION


Section 8.01 Dissolution Upon the Occurrence of Specified Events. The occurrence of any of the following events or conditions will cause the Company to dissolve automatically:


- (a) Term. At the end of the duration as provided in ARTICLE II.
- (b) Unanimous written consent. The written consent of all members to dissolve, wind up and liquidate the Company.

Except for prior amendment to this section, no act by the Company or its members can avoid that dissolution.

Section 8.02 Cessation of Membership. The cessation of membership of one or more members will not result in the dissolution of the Company.
