ARTICLE EIGHT CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

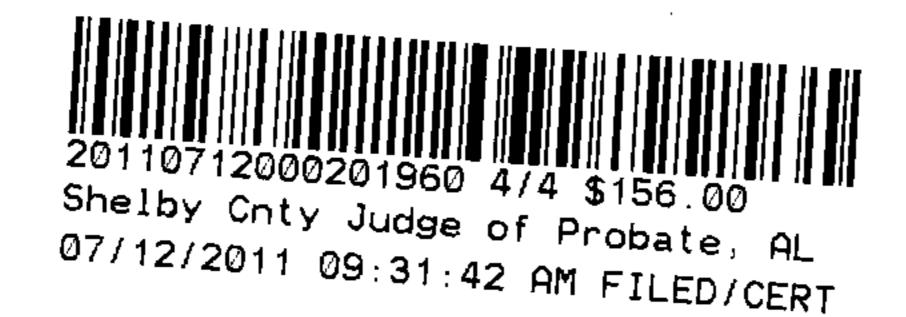
The cessation of membership of one or more members will not result in the dissolution of the Company.

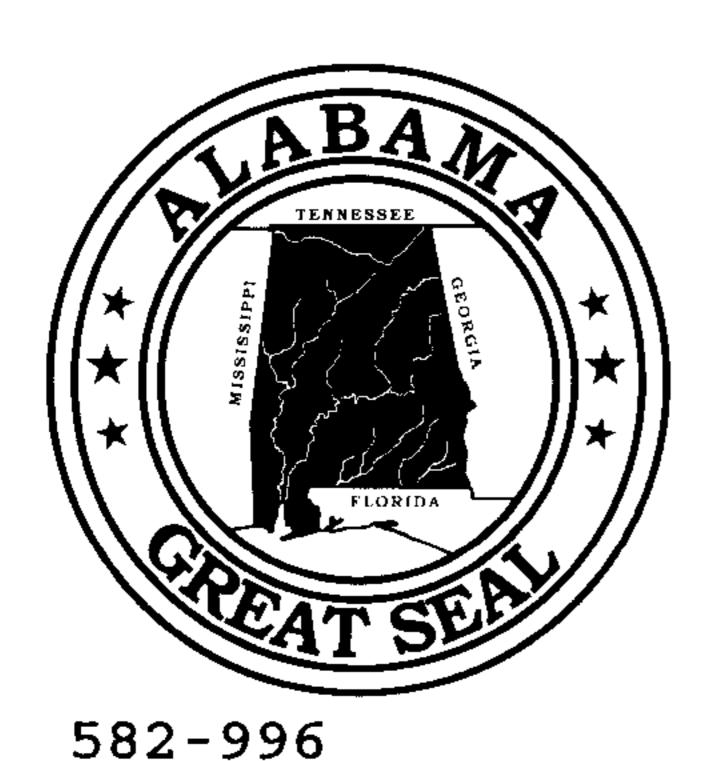
