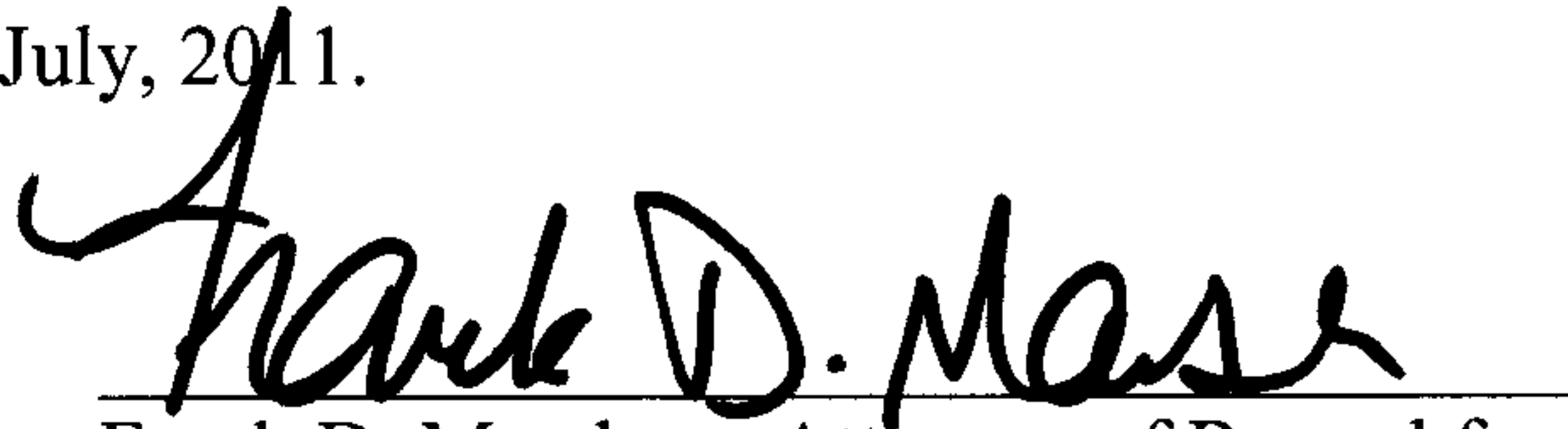

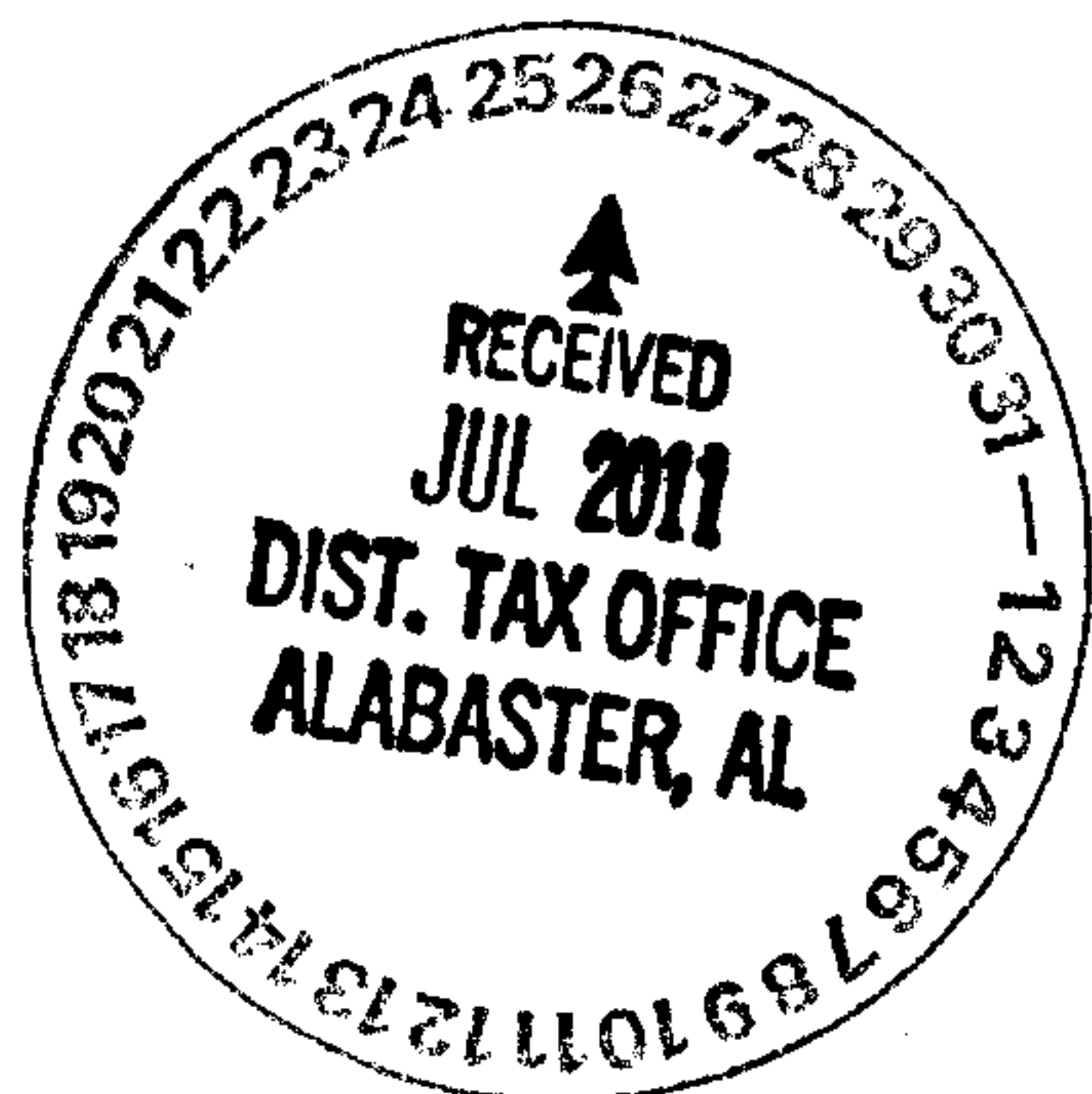
WHEREAS, the delinquent tax covered by said certificate of lien has been paid in full, said lien is hereby released, canceled and discharged of record.
