
**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the Alabama Business Corporation Act and the general corporation laws of the State of Alabama, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

The name of the corporation shall be **AVALON BLUE INTERIORS, INC.** The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE II

The number of directors of the initial Board of Directors shall be one (1) and the name and address of the director chosen for the first year, and until their successor is duly elected and qualified, are as follows:

The object and purpose for which the said corporation is formed and the object to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

- (a) To market furniture;
- (b) To perform consulting to prospective clients with regard to Interior Design;
- (c) To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire, to own, hold, and operate, and to sell, mortgage, pledge, lease, employ, or otherwise dispose of, encumber, or invest in such real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, and all types of personal property, tangible or intangible, as may be reasonably required in the conduct of its business activity in which the corporation may engage.

- (d) To enter into and make all necessary contracts for the conduct of its business with any person, partnership, association, corporation, or other entity, and to perform, carry out, cancel, and rescind those contracts;
- (e) To borrow or raise money reasonably required in the conduct of its business and in connection with any proper business activity in which the corporation may be engaged; and to execute and deliver any instruments that may be necessary to evidence the borrowing;
- (f) To carry on any other business in connection with and incidental to any of the foregoing businesses, transactions, and dealings; and to do any other act legal under the laws of the State of Alabama with all the powers conferred on a corporation by the laws of the State of Alabama.
- (g) To restrict the manner in which the persons to whom its capital stock shall be issued or transferred and to enact bylaws to carry these restrictions into effect;
- (h) To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of the corporate purpose of the attainment of any of the objectives or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, incidental to, pertaining to, or growing out of its business or otherwise, and at all times to comply with the provisions of the Revised Alabama Professional Corporation Act as currently enacted and as may be hereafter amended or suspended by any other statute.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have and be invested with all rights and powers authorized by the laws and constitution of the State of Alabama, and shall have the right and power to do all things authorized by the laws of the State of Alabama as fully and to the extent as natural persons might or could do, subject only to such limitations and restrictions as are placed on corporations under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE VI

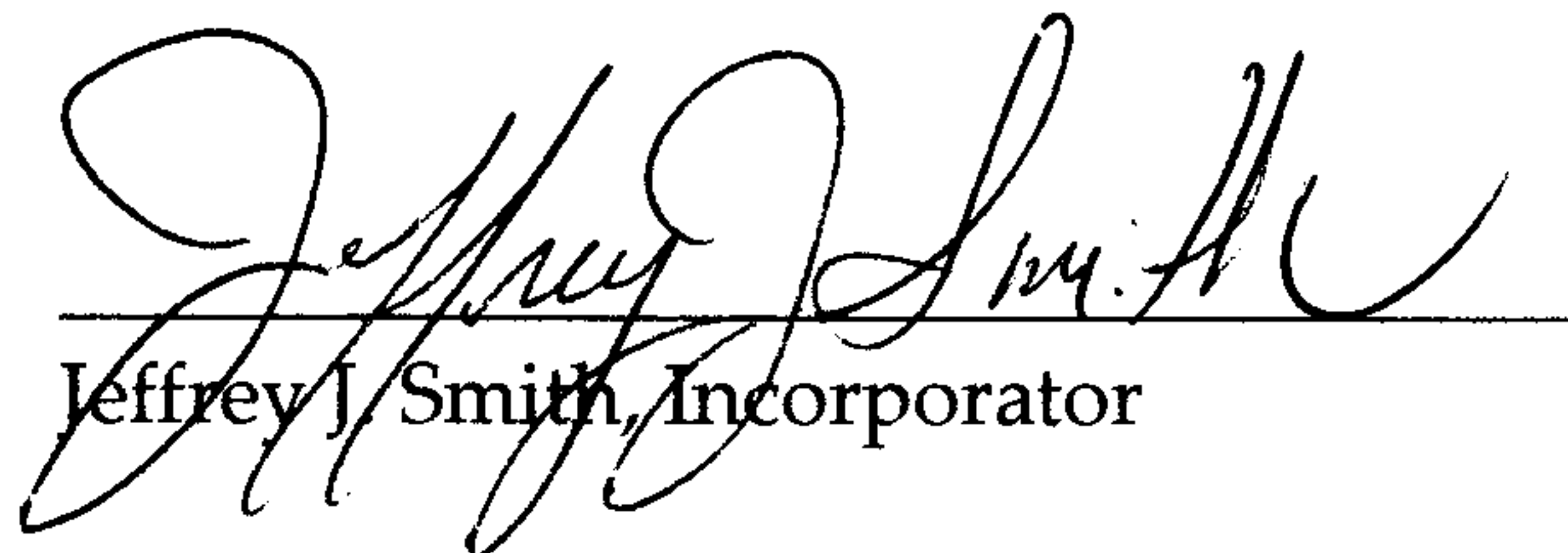

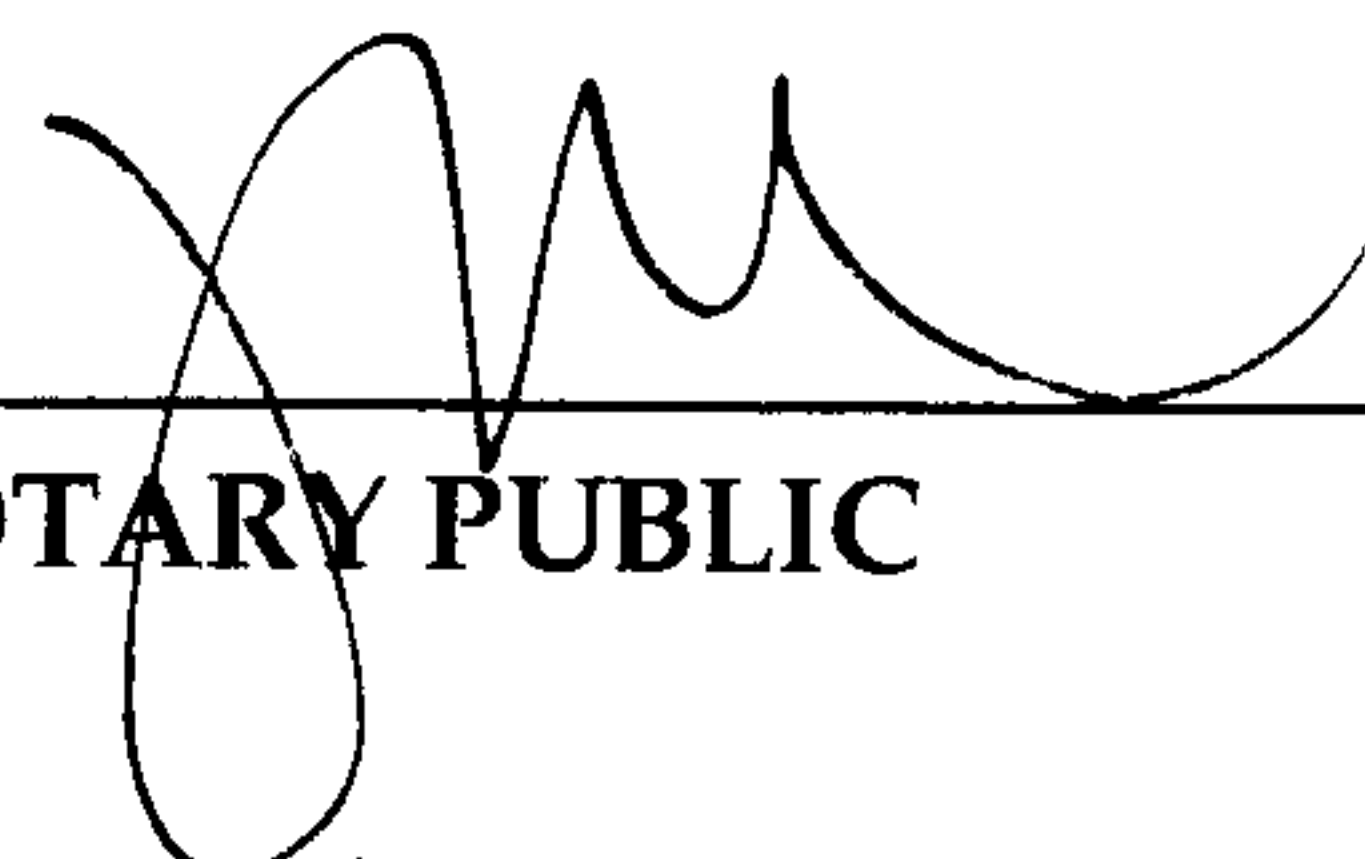
