Know Ye, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847.

John Franks, father, and heir at Law of James F. Franks, deceased, late a private in Captain Ackers Company, Second, Regiment of Mississippi Volunteers,

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *his* favor, numbered *16 047*.

Conoley*, Assignee of said *John Franks*, and to his heirs, the West half of the South West Quarter of Section thirty three, and the East half of the South East Quarter of Section thirty two, in Township twenty-one North, of Range two West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, Containing one hundred and sixty Acres, and sixty two and a half hundredths of an Acre,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract ^{Except paid for per Receiver's Receipt numbered 26.612.} has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned War-

rant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847, TO HAVE AND

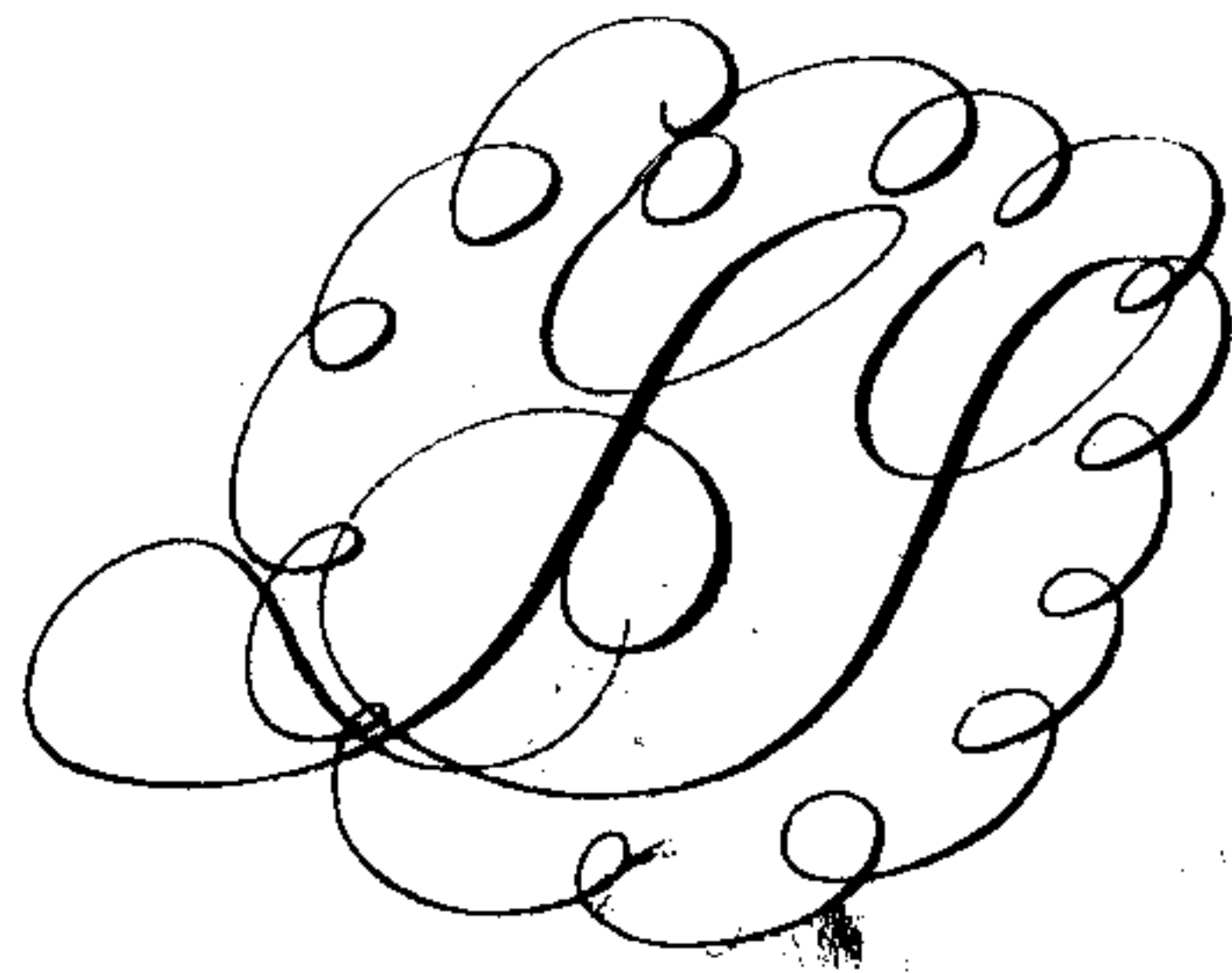
TO HOLD the said *parts of said* sections of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said
