TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said grantees, as joint tenants, with right of survivorship,
successively, their heirs and assigns forever, it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless
the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein) upon the
death of any one of said grantees, the entire interest in said property shall vest in the remaining survivors, as
joint tenants, with right of survivorship, and that upon the death of either of the two said survivors, the said
property shall vest in the survivor of them and that the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to and vest in the
last surviving grantee herein named, but if any grantee herein named survives the other or others, such as in case
of the death in a common accident, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in
common.

their heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons.
