LOTS 2201 AND 2204, ACCORDING TO THE SURVEY OF HIGHLAND LAKES 22<sup>ND</sup> SECTOR PHASE I, AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 33, PAGE 79 A&B IN THE PROBATE OFFICE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA
