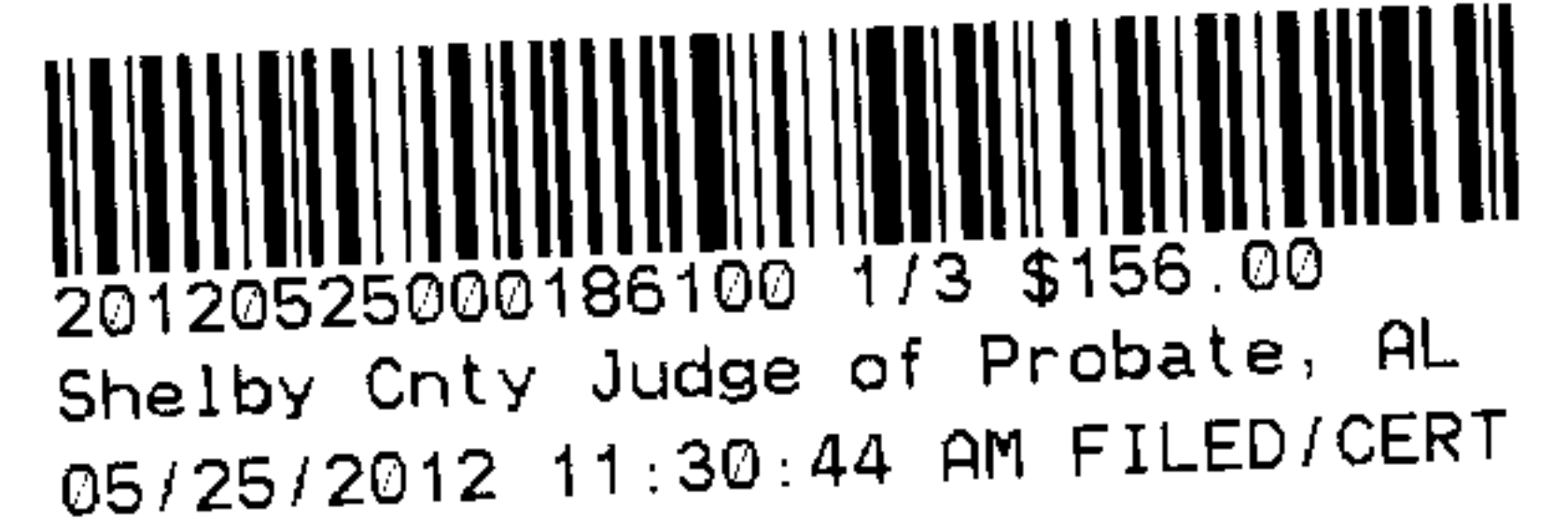


**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
348712 COFFEE CAFÉ, INC.**



Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Business Corporation Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is **348712 COFFEE CAFÉ, INC.**

ARTICLE TWO

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

The corporation has been organized for the purpose of owning and operating a restaurant.

ARTICLE FOUR

The corporation shall have authority, acting by its Board of Directors, to issue 1,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE FIVE

The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be David Belcher, and the address of the initial registered agent of the corporation shall be 480 Cahaba Valley Road (Highway 119), Suite A, City of Pelham, County of Shelby, State of Alabama, 35124

ARTICLE SIX

The names and addresses of the initial Directors shall be as follows: Kadirali Chunara, 2199 Glenmore Lane, City of Snellville, County of Gwinnett, State of Georgia, 30078; and, Yasmin Charania, 480 Cahaba Valley Road (Highway 119), Suite A, City of Pelham, County of Shelby, State of Alabama, 35124.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The name of the sole incorporator of the corporation is Paul S. Suda, Esq., and the address of the sole incorporator of the corporation shall be 1362 Salem Drive, City of Alpharetta, County of Fulton, State of Georgia, 30009.

A handwritten signature in black ink is located in the bottom right corner of the document. The signature appears to be "P. Suda".

ARTICLE EIGHT

A director of the corporation shall not be personally liable to the corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for breach of duty of care or other duty as a director, except for liability (i) for any appropriation, in violation of his duties, of any business opportunity of the corporation, (ii) for acts or omissions which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law, or (iii) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit. Any repeal or modification of the provisions of this Article by the shareholders of the corporation shall be prospective only, and shall not adversely affect any limitation on the personal liability of a director of the corporation with respect to any act or omissions occurring prior to the effective date of such repeal or modification.

If the Alabama Business Corporation Act is hereafter amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of directors, then the liability of a director of the corporation, in addition to the limitation on personal liability provided herein, shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by the amended Alabama Business Corporation Act.


ARTICLE NINE

The corporation shall be organized and managed so that it is a "SMALL BUSINESS CORPORATION" as defined in IRC SEC. 1244(c)(1), as amended. Compliance with this section will enable shareholders to treat the loss of the sale or exchange of their shares as an "ordinary loss" on their personal income tax returns. Accordingly, the sale and issuance of shares will be conducted in compliance of IRC SEC. 1244, so that the corporation and its shareholders may obtain the benefits of IRC SEC. 1244. Therefore, the proper officers of the corporation are directed to maintain such accounting records as are necessary so that any shareholder who experiences a loss on the transfer of common shares of the corporation may determine whether they qualify for "ordinary loss" deduction treatment on their personal income tax returns.

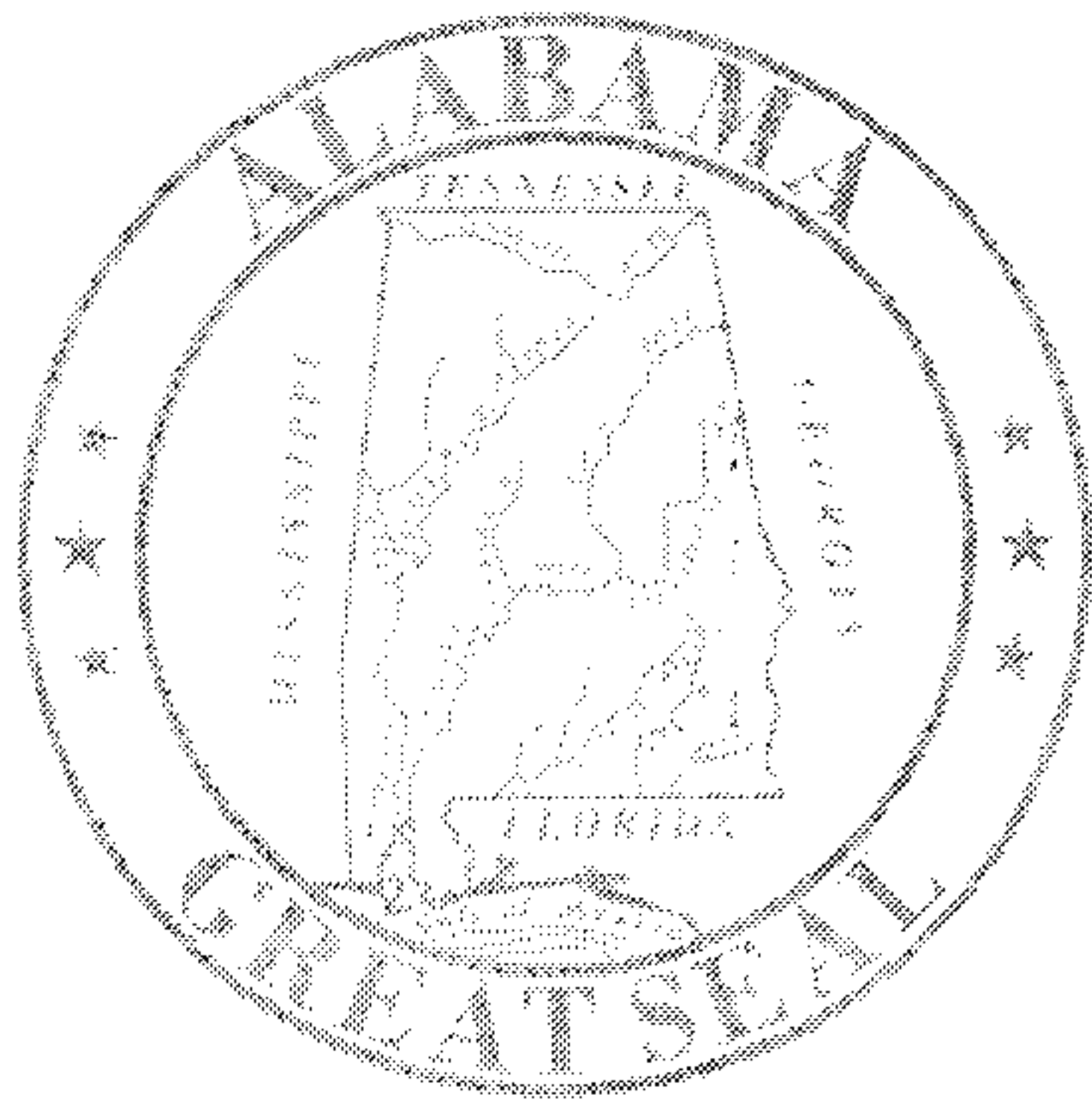
