
AUCTIONEER'S DEED



STATE OF ALABAMA COUNTY OF SHELBY

WHEREAS, CHRISTOPHER S. CLECKLER and ELIZABETH R. CLECKLER, husband and wife executed a mortgage to Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc.
