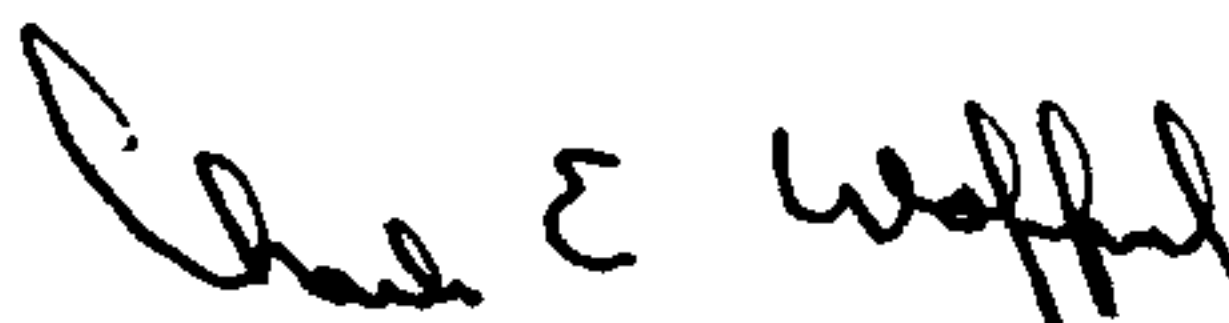

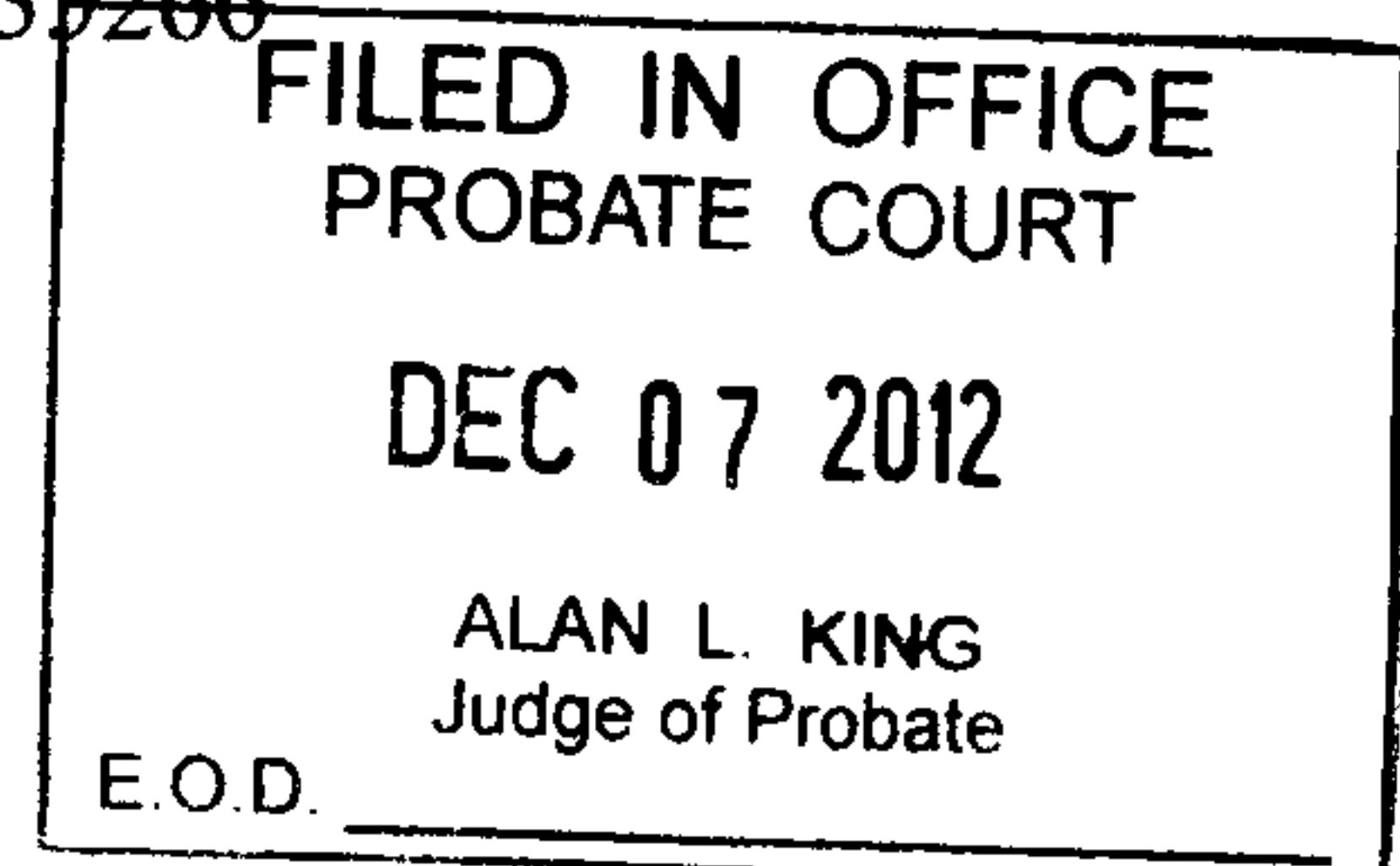
4. Waivers of the probate of this Will are filed with this petition.

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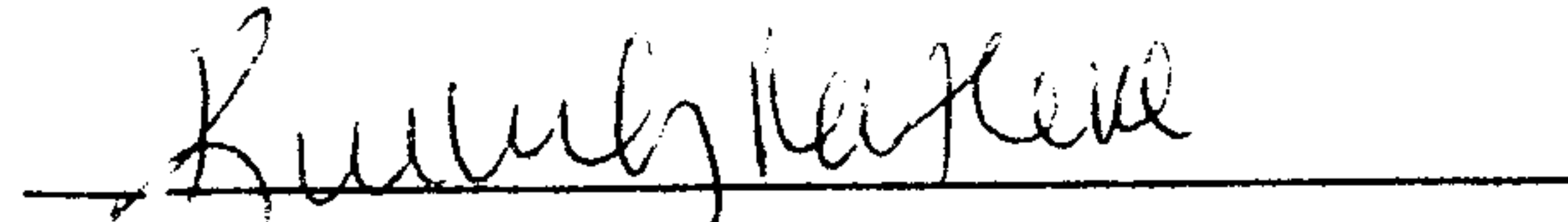

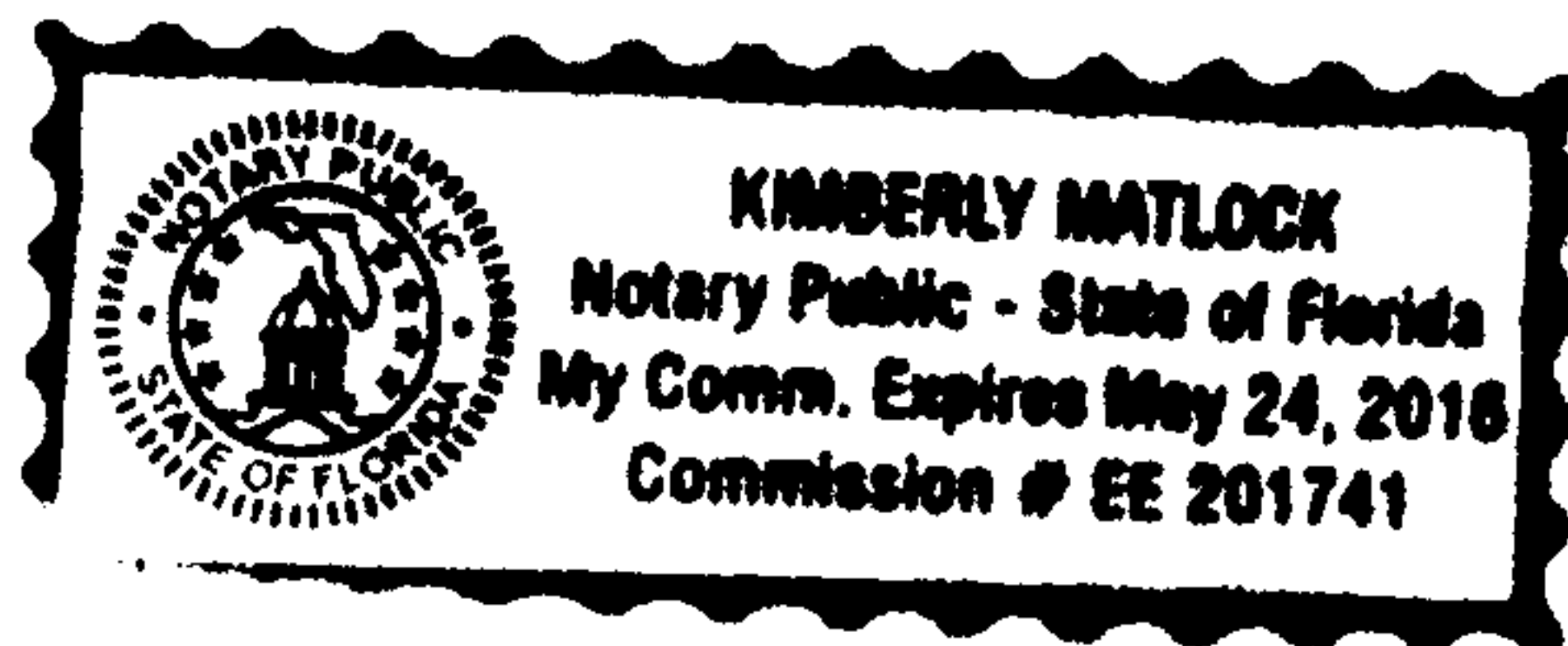

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, **CHARLES EDWARD WOFFORD, SR.**, a resident of Jefferson County, State of Alabama, being over the age of nineteen (19) years and of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all other Wills and Codicils heretofore made by me.

ARTICLE I

I direct that my funeral expenses, taxes and just debts shall be paid out of my estate by my Executor, hereinafter named, as soon after my death as may be possible.

ARTICLE II

I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate real, personal, and mixed, whether acquired before or after the execution of this Will, including property over which I may have any power of appointment, in equal shares, to my sons, **CHARLES EDWARD WOFFORD, JR.** and **STEPHEN FRED WOFFORD**, absolutely and in fee simple, if they survive me. Should either of my said sons predecease me or, for any reason, fail to take, then I give, devise and bequeath his share to the surviving son. Should my said sons both fail to survive me, then, I give, devise and bequeath to my mother, **EVELYN WOFFORD**, if she survives me, absolutely and in fee simple, the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed, wheresoever situated and whether acquired before or after the execution of this Will, including property over which I may have any power of appointment.

ARTICLE III

I hereby nominate and appoint my son, **CHARLES EDWARD WOFFORD, JR.**, as sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. Should the said **CHARLES EDWARD WOFFORD, JR.** predecease me, fail, refuse, or cease to act as Executor, I appoint my son, **STEPHEN FRED WOFFORD** as Successor Executor. I direct that neither my Executor, nor

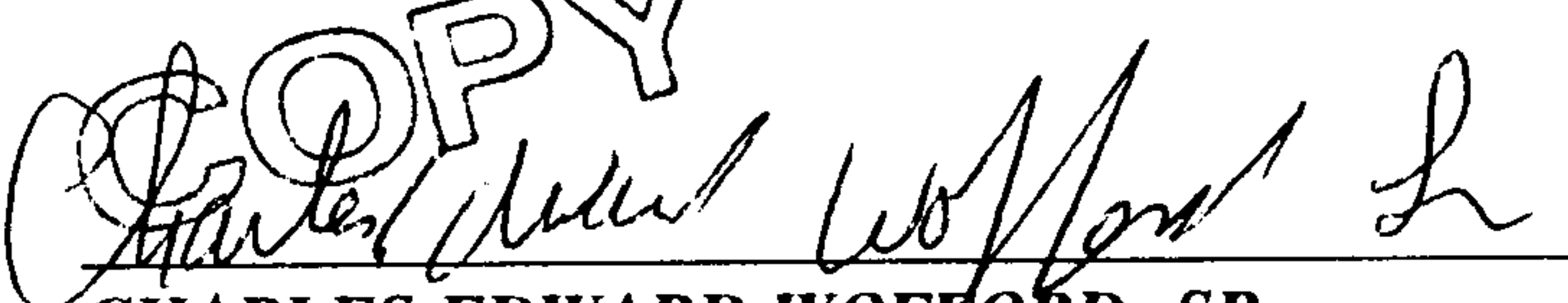
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any successor, shall be required to post any bond, file any inventory or make any report of my estate to any Court. I hereby vest my Executor, including his successors, (referred to as fiduciaries but including all fiduciaries) with the following powers, authority, duties and directions:

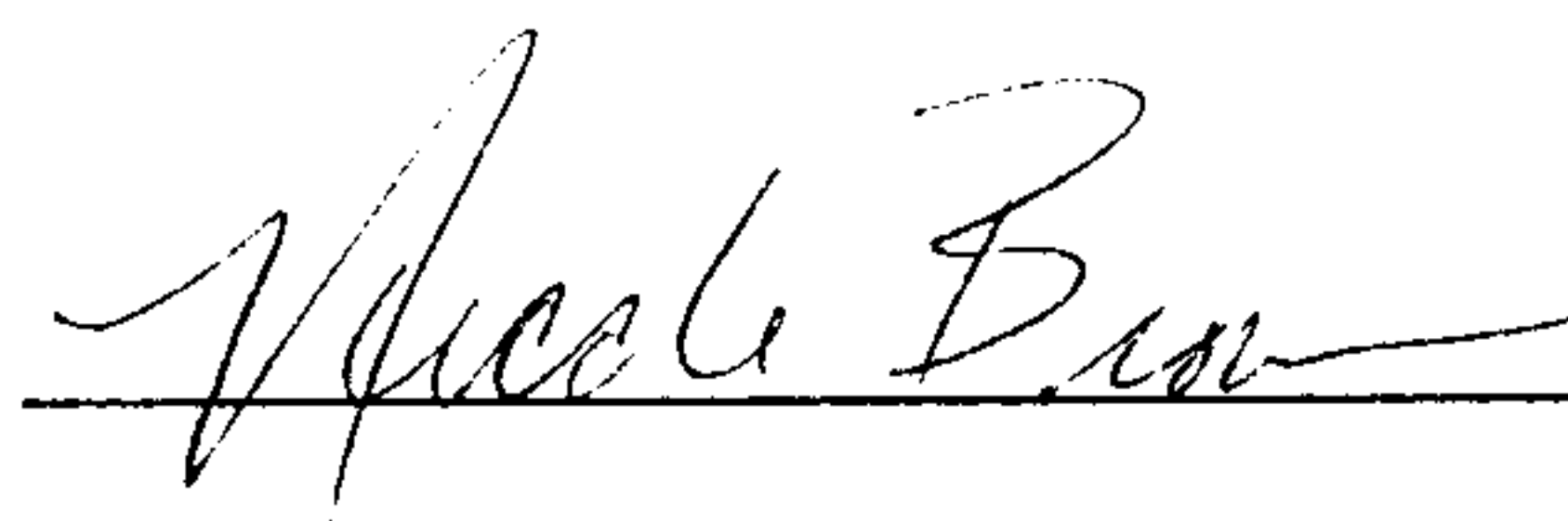
To hold and manage said property and such other property as the fiduciary may subsequently acquire pursuant to the power and authority herein given to him with full power to collect the income therefrom and from time to time to sell, convey, exchange, lease for a period of beyond the possible termination of the administration of my estate or for a less period, improve, encumber, or otherwise dispose of all or any portion of said property in such manner and upon such terms and conditions including credit, as the fiduciary may in his absolute discretion approve, with full power to invest and reinvest said receipts of sale or disposal of any portion of such property, real or personal as suitable to the fiduciary and to change investments and make new investments from time to time as to the fiduciary may seem necessary or desirable, regardless of whether such property or securities are a so-called "legal" investment of trust funds, and to do every other act and thing necessary or appropriate for the complete administration of my estate.

I, **CHARLES EDWARD WOFFORD, SR.**, the testator sign my name to this instrument this 15 day of March, 2000, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and Testament, and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am nineteen (19) years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.
