

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CVLC, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Business Corporation Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

The name of the corporation is:

CVLC, Inc.

Article II

Duration

The period of its duration is perpetual.

Article III

<u>Purposes</u>

The corporation has been organized for the following purposes:

- 1. To engage in the business of providing a child care development program and center; and
- 2. The transaction of any or all lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the Alabama Business Corporations Act.

Article IV

Authorized Capital Stock

The aggregate number of shares of capital stock which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 1000 shares of common stock, par value of \$1.00 per share.

Article V

Registered Office/Agent

The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 151 Narrows Parkway, Suite E, Birmingham, Alabama 35242 and the name of its initial registered agent at this address is Constance Mankowich.

Article VI

Board of Directors

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is one (1) and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders and until their successors are elected and shall qualify are as follows:

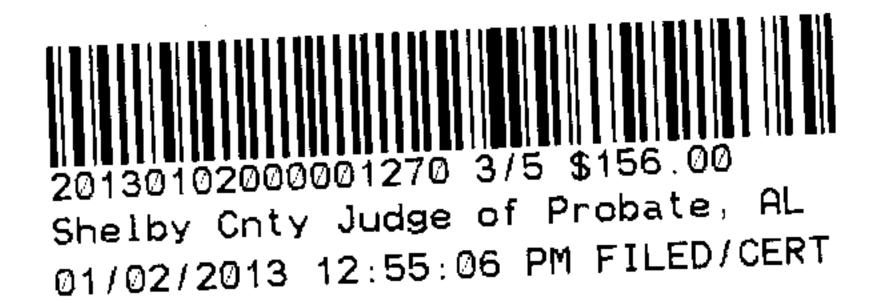
Article VIII

Restriction on Transfer of Stock

Each share of capital stock shall be subject to a condition that the transfer of such stock is restricted in that such stock may not be sold to any person or organization which is not then currently a stockholder in the corporation without first tendering the shares to the corporation by notice addressed to the Board of Directors, and then in turn to the other shareholders of the corporation in proportion to their then existing share ownerships interests (after disregarding the shares being offered for sale) at the same price and on the same terms as offered to the proposed purchaser. A copy of the offer to purchase or sell must be sent to the Board of Directors with the notice.

Each certificate representing shares of the capital stock shall bear a legend stating in substance that the capital stock is subject to this Restriction on Transfer.

The corporation shall not be obligated to transfer on its books or to recognize for voting or any other purpose any stock sale not conforming with this Article.

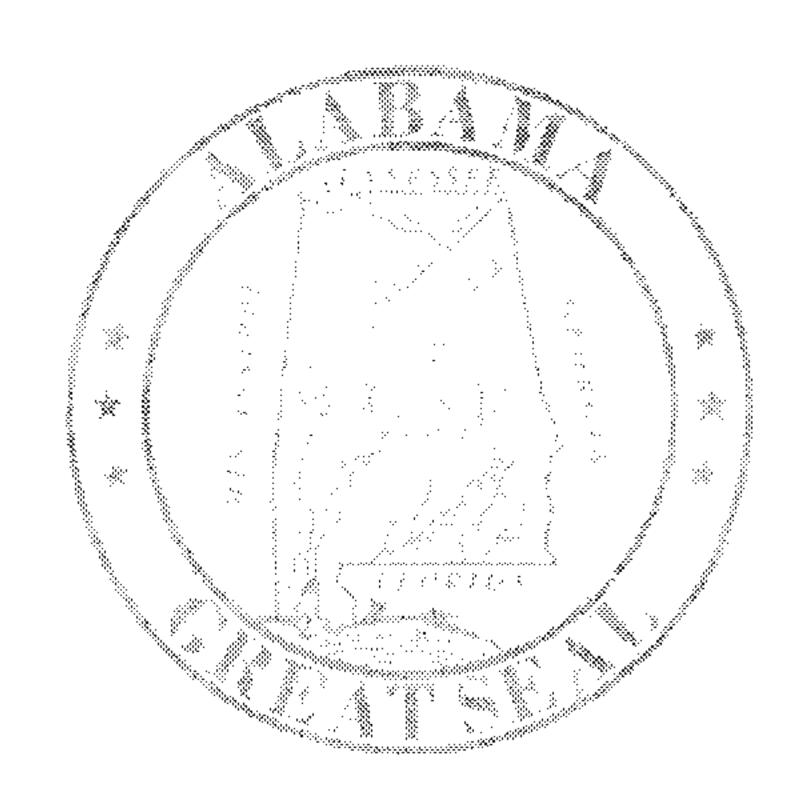
